Design & work: Kokka Fabric

Size: about 28cm (l)
about 20cm (w)
about 10cm (d)

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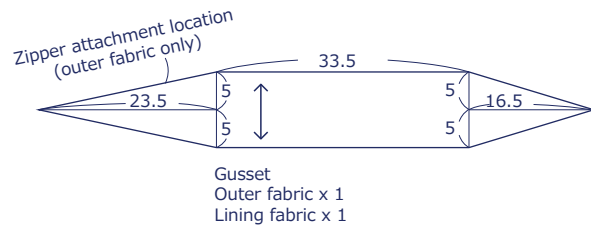
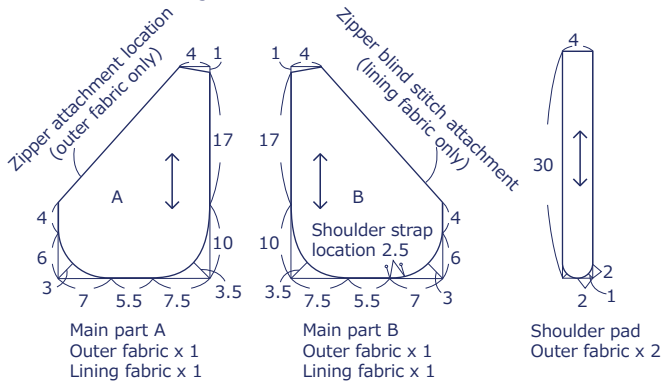
Materials

- Outer Fabric (Laminated Fabric): 110cm wide × 50cm
- Lining Fabric: 110cm wide × 50cm
- Zipper: 30cm × 1
- Flat tape: 25mm wide × 50cm
- Square ring: 25mm wide × 1
- Rectangle buckle: 25mm wide × 1

Fabric shown for this sample: YK51070-1C(Laminated fabric)

Pattern

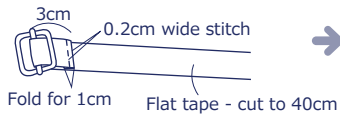
Unit: cm. When cutting the fabric, add 1cm seam allowance.



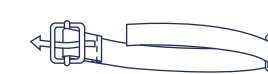
Instructions

1. Make the shoulder strap and baste it to the Main part B outer fabric

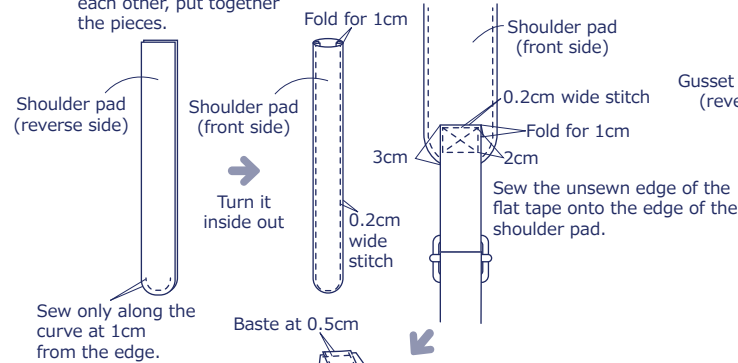
Put through the flat tape in the middle of the rectangle buckle. Fold in three and sew to secure.



Put through the unsewn end of the flat tape to the square ring first, then put it through the rectangle buckle.

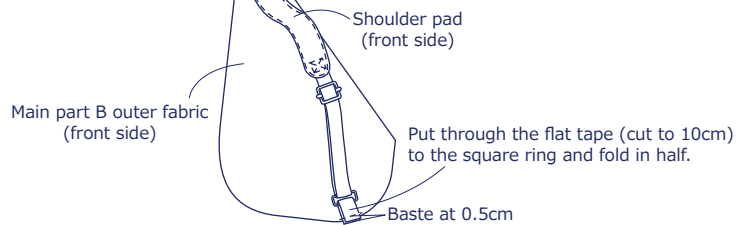


With the front sides facing each other, put together the pieces.



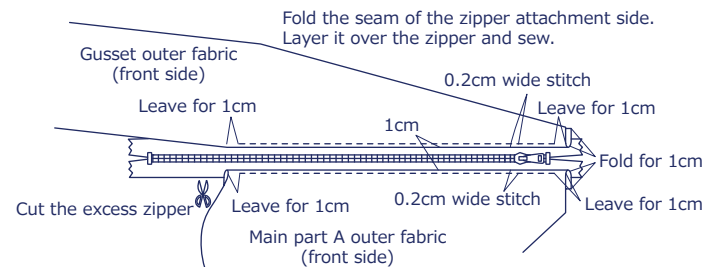
Sew only along the curve at 1cm from the edge.

Baste at 0.5cm

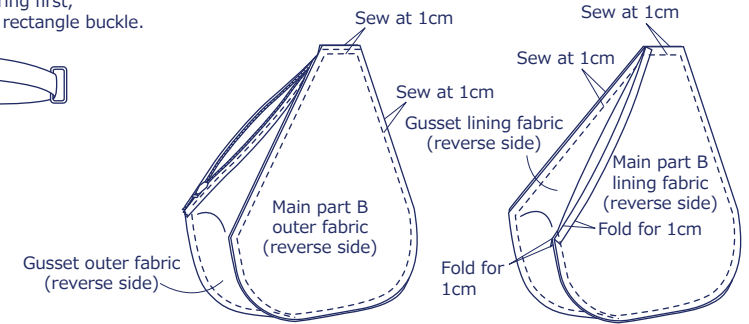


2. Attach the zipper to the Main part A outer fabric and gusset

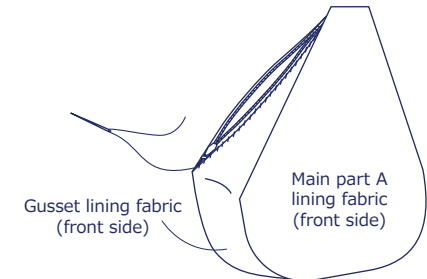
Fold the seam of the zipper attachment side. Layer it over the zipper and sew.



3. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the main part and gusset.



4. With the front sides facing outside, put together the outer fabric and lining fabric at the opening using blind stitches



5. Turn it inside out using the zipper opening. Align the shape to finish
