



Soft and Fluffy Gathered Bag

Size : 24cm (l) x 24cm (w)

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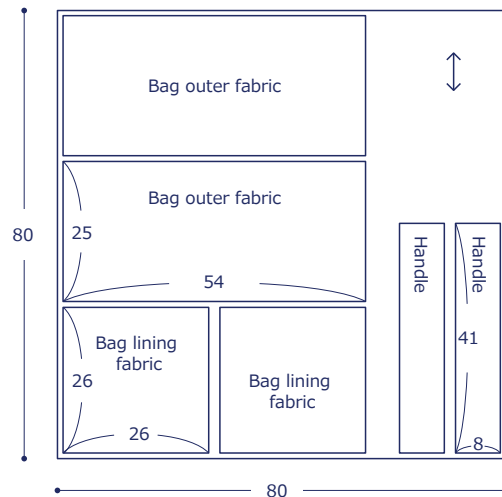
Materials

- Fabric: 80cm×80cm
- Fusible interfacing (thin): 80cm×50cm
- Domett Interlining (thin): 60cm×50cm
- Button: Two pieces (1.3cm diameter)

Fabric shown for this sample: naniIRO Fuwari fuwari JG10410 (A) Hikari No Kuni

Pattern and Cutting Layout

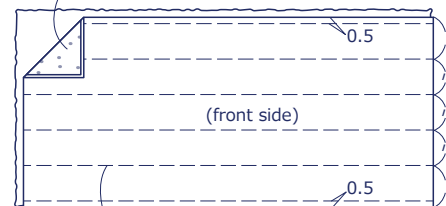
All measurements are in centimeters (cm.)
The edges are left cut. Cut the fabric after edges are aligned.



Instructions

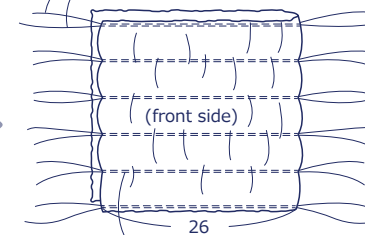
1. Make the bag outer fabric.

①Adhere fusible interfacing.



②Layer the domett interlining and sew with rough stitches.

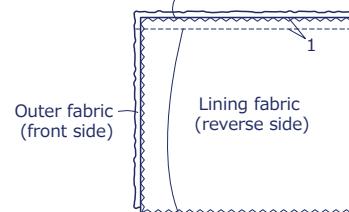
③Pull the thread from ② to create gathering.
(Hold the start and finish with a clip)



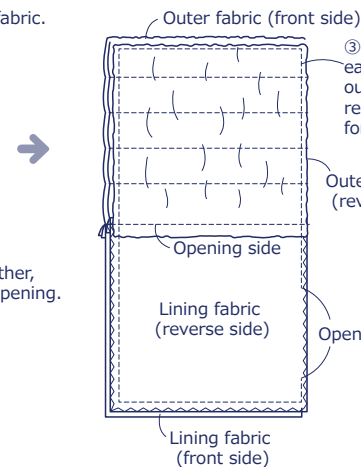
④Run stitches over the rough stitch line from ③ to secure gathering.
*Make two pieces

2. Sew together the bag outer fabric and lining fabric.

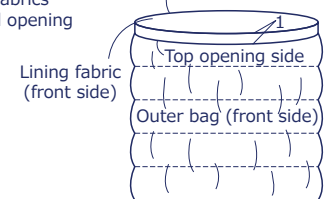
①Serge the edge of the lining fabric.



② With the front sides facing each other, sew together the fabrics at the top opening.
*Make two pieces

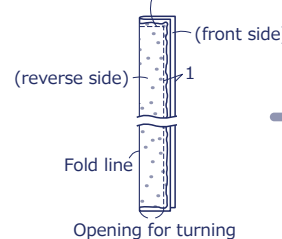


④Turn it inside out and fold the top opening as shown.
Close the opening for turning.

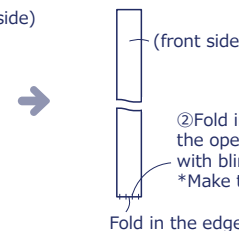


3. Make the handles.

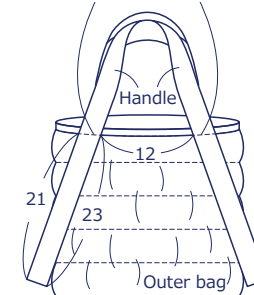
①Adhere interfacing. With the front sides facing each other, fold in half and sew, leaving an opening for turning.



②Fold in the edge of the opening and close with blind stitches.
*Make two pieces



③Attach the handle.



④Cross the end of the handles and attach a button to secure.
