## Materials

☐ Outer fabric: 110cm wide × 60cm ☐ Lining fabric: 90cm wide × 50cm

☐ Fusible interfacing (Thick): 110cm wide × 75cm


☐ Flat tape (4.5cm wide): 92cm

Fabric shown for this sample: H11500-501 (A)

## **Pattern and Cutting Layout**

Unit: cm


Add 1cm seam allowance when cutting the fabric.



\* Adhere fusible interfacing on the back of all the outer fabrics.

1. With the front sides facing each other, piece together the facing and lining panel fabric.

4. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the outer bag and lining bag at the opening.




m open. Sew at 1cm Facing (reverse side)

Outer bag (reverse side)

Press the seam open.

2. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the sides of the outer bag panel fabric and lining bag panel fabric respectively.


5. Turn the bag inside out using an opening for turning. Apply stitching around the top opening.





**X** Close the opening for turning.

3. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the bag panel and bottom.



\* Repeat the process for lining fabric.
