
Materials



Cutting Layout

(): Seam allowance. Add 1cm seam allowance unless specified otherwise. Adhere fusible interfacing on the back of the facing.



Instructions

1. Make the facing.

<Neckline>


① Apply zigzag stitches on the outer edge of the fabric.

② With the front sides facing each other, sew the shoulder.


Back neckline facing (front side)
③ Press the seam open.
(reverse side)

3. Finish the neckline.

① With the front sides facing each other, sew together the body and neckline facing.







3 Turn it over and sew.

<Armhole>

Papply zigzag stitches on the outer edge of the fabric.

 With the front sides facing outside, sew the shoulder.

Back neckline facing (front side)


(front side)

3 Sew the side.
4 Press the seams from
2 & 3 open.
Make one piece for each side.

4. Sew the sides.


 With the front sides facing each other, sew the sides of the front and back body together from the top to where the slit starts.



5. Finish the armhole.

Finish the armhole by piecing together the body and armhole facing like in step $\boxed{3}$.

2. Sew the shoulder.



6. Finish the hem.
