



## **Tote Bag with Diagonal Handles**

Design & work: Kokka Fabric

Size: about 30cm (I) about 50cm (w)

about 14cm (d - excluding handles)

**Materials** 

□ Outer Fabric: 110cm wide x 60cm ☐ Lining Fabric: 110cm wide x 70cm

☐ Fusible interfacing (heavy weight): 110cm wide x 70cm


Fabric shown for this sample: (Outer Fabric)YK-51100-2B

## **Pattern and Cutting Layout**

Unit: Centimeters (cm) [ ]: seam allowance

Add 1cm seam allowance when cutting the fabric unless otherwise specified.





\* Adhere fusible interfacing on the back of outer bag fabric and handles.

## Instructions

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
1. Make the handles and attach them to the outer bag fabric

Fold the handle in four. Apply stitches on both longer ends. 0.2cm wide stitch Fold for 1cm. Handle (front side) \* Make two pieces. 0.2cm wide stitch


Fold the center of the handle in half and apply stitches.




Attach the handle to the specified location.




2. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the bag fabrics at the bottom.



3. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the bag fabrics at the sides with folded gusset



5. Turn the bag inside out and apply stitches at the top opening



\* Close the opening for turning.
