Materials


□ Fabric: (Front and Back Body) 112cm width x 2.0m (Strap (Linen)) 112cm width x 5cm

☐ Button: One piece (1.5cm diameter)

Fabric shown for this sample: Framework JG41800-800 (A)

Pattern and Cutting layout

All measurements are in centimeters (cm). The edges are left cut.



Instructions

1. Make gathering.


On the top side, run rough stitches.
Pull the thread and shrink the width to 30cm.
(Front body should have an even gathering.
For the back, place more gathering in the center.)



② Press the side seam open 2. Sew the side edges. and run stitches above the opening position. Stop stitches here. (opening position) Stop stitches here. (opening position) 1) With front/outer sides facing each other, Back body put together the front (front/outer side) and back body and sew the side edges up to (reverse side) Front body -the opening position. (reverse side) Opening position.

3. Attach the strap.

 $\ensuremath{\textcircled{1}}$ With front/outer sides facing outside, fold the strap and crease.



② As shown, place the strap and front and back bodies together and sew.
