

Raglan Sleeve Blouse

Size: Medium


Instructions

1. Adhere interfacing to the reverse side of both front and back neckline and cuff.

2. Run rough stitches at the cuff opening.



3. With front/outer sides facing each other, sew together the sleeve and bodies.




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Front body (front/outer side)

5. Attach the neckline.

With front/outer sides facing each other, sew together the bodies and front neckline at 1cm. Turn the back neckline inside and run stitches on the front side.




Cuff (front/outer side)



With front/outer sides facing each other, sew together the cuff and the end of the sleeve. Run topstitches on the front/outer side.

Sleeve Sleeve Stitch at 0.2cm. (front/outer side) Fold at 1cm₄ (front/outer side) Sleeve Scored line (front/outer side) Cuf (reverse side) Sew at 1cm. Gather the fabric to Cuff adjust the length. (front/outer side) (front/outer side)

8. Double fold the hem and run topstitches to finish.






Cutting Layout

All measurements are in centimeters (cm), Numbers in () denote seam allowance, Add the seam allowance when you cut the fabric. All seam allowances 1cm unless









4. Prepare the neckline

With front/outer sides facing each other, sew around the front and back neckline.
