



Sheep Shaped Throw Pillow

32cm (l) x 56cm (w)

Materials (for red sheep)

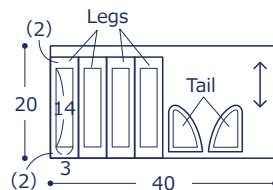
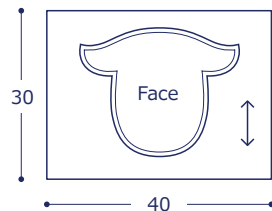
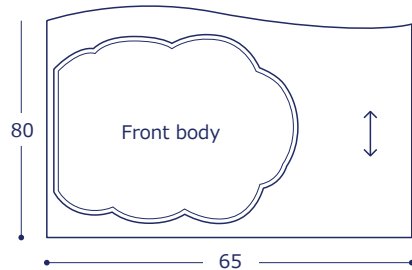
- Fabric : (Body) 65cm×80cm
(Face) 40cm×30cm
(Legs and Tail) 40cm×20cm
- Button: Two pieces (1.5cm diameter)
- #25 Embroidery Thread
- Batting for stuffing

Fabric shown for this sample: P29400-400 (A)

Cutting Layout

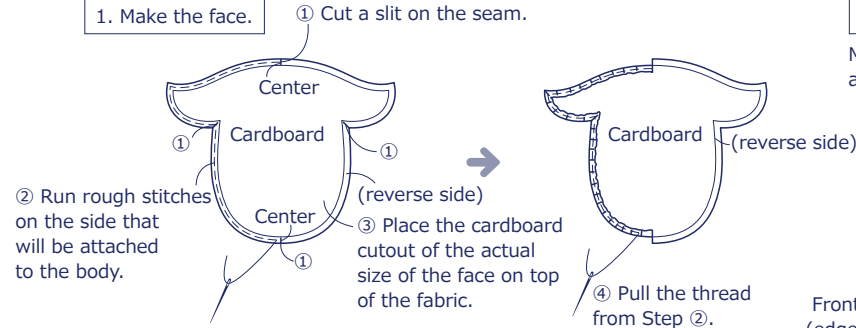
All measurements are in centimeters (cm). Numbers in () denote seam allowance.
All seam allowances 1cm unless otherwise stated.

For the back body, refer to sewing instructions.



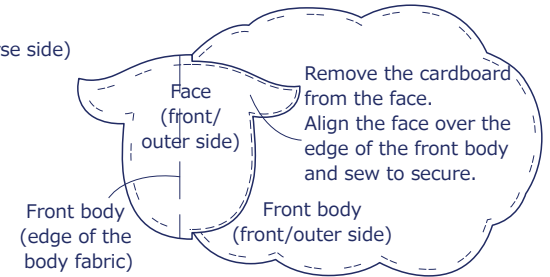
Instructions

1. Make the face.

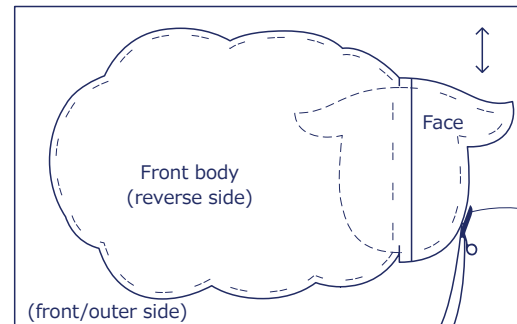


2. Make the front part of the pillow.

Match the center of the face with the mark at the left edge of the front body.



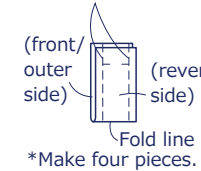
3. Cut the fabric for the back body.



4. Make legs and tail.

<Legs>

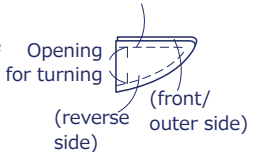
Fold the fabric with front/outer sides facing inside. Sew both edges.



*Make four pieces.

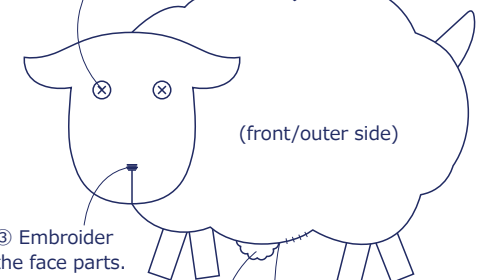
<Tail>

With front/outer sides facing each other, sew the pieces together leaving an opening for turning.



6. Stuff the body with batting and embellish.

② Attach the buttons.

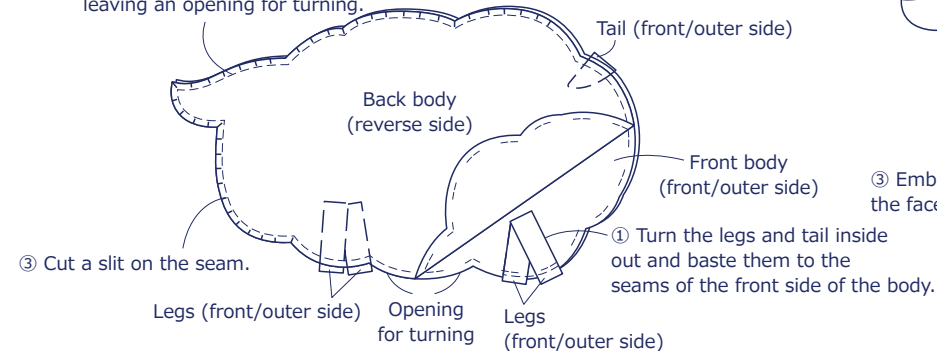


③ Embroider the face parts.

① Turn the body inside out, stuff it with batting and close the opening.

5. Piece together the front and back bodies.

② With front/outer sides facing each other, sew together the front and back body, leaving an opening for turning.



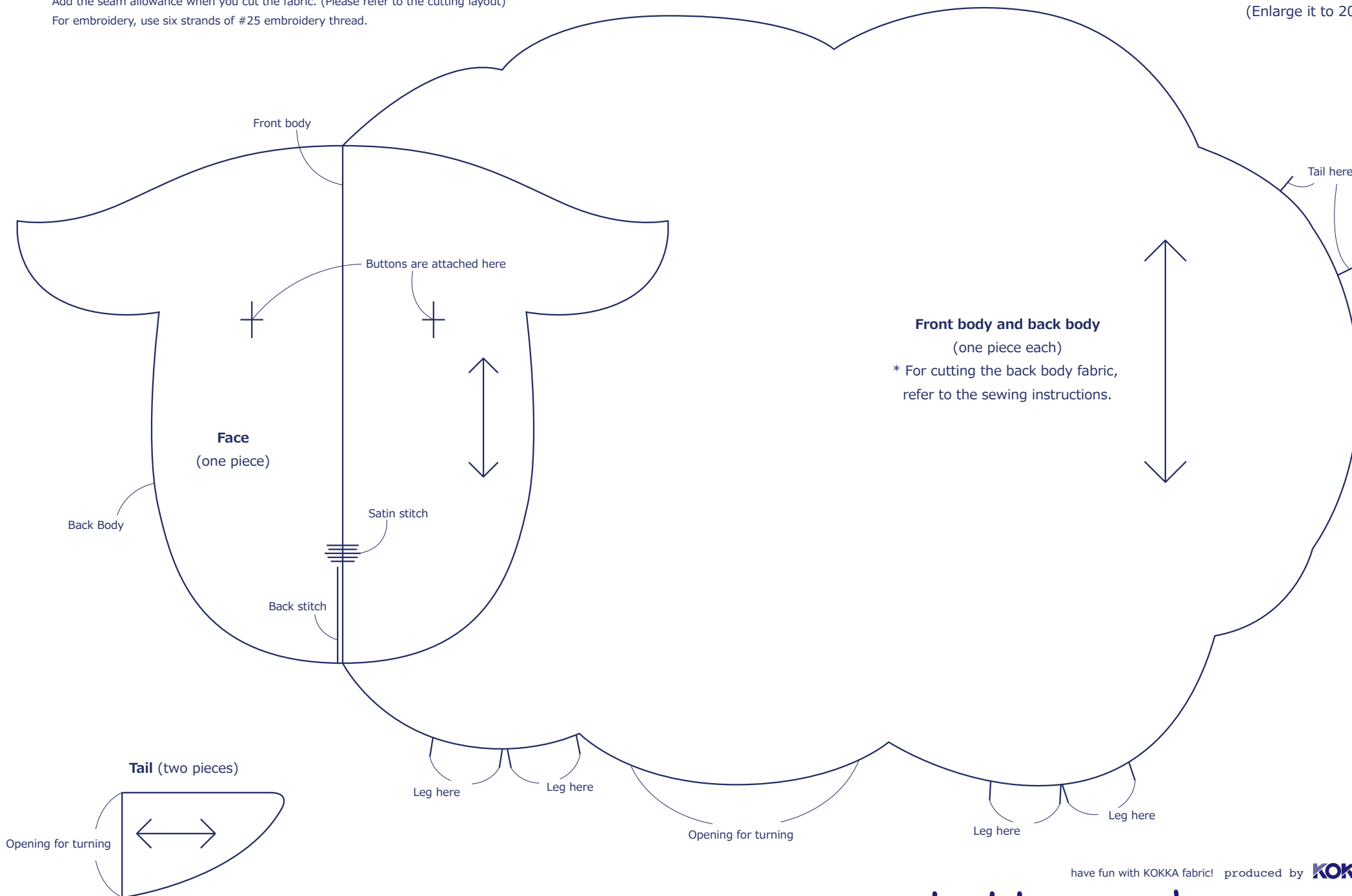
③ Cut a slit on the seam.

Legs (front/outer side) Opening for turning Legs (front/outer side)

Add the seam allowance when you cut the fabric. (Please refer to the cutting layout)
For embroidery, use six strands of #25 embroidery thread.
