Size: 18.8cm (l) x 13.6cm (w)

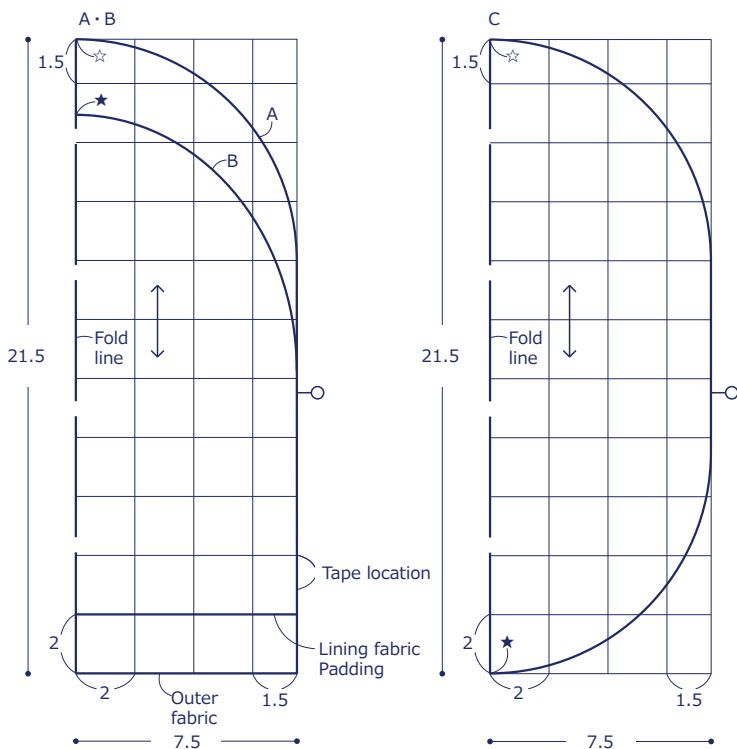
Materials (for one mitt)

- Fabric (Outer fabric A, B): 40cm×30cm
(Outer fabric C (cotton flannel)): 20cm×30cm
(Lining fabric (velour)) : 50cm×30cm
(Padding (thick terry cloth)): 50cm×30cm
- Tape: 1cm wide x 10cm

Fabric shown for this sample: (Outer fabric A, B) echino JG96000-604
(B), (C), (D), (E)

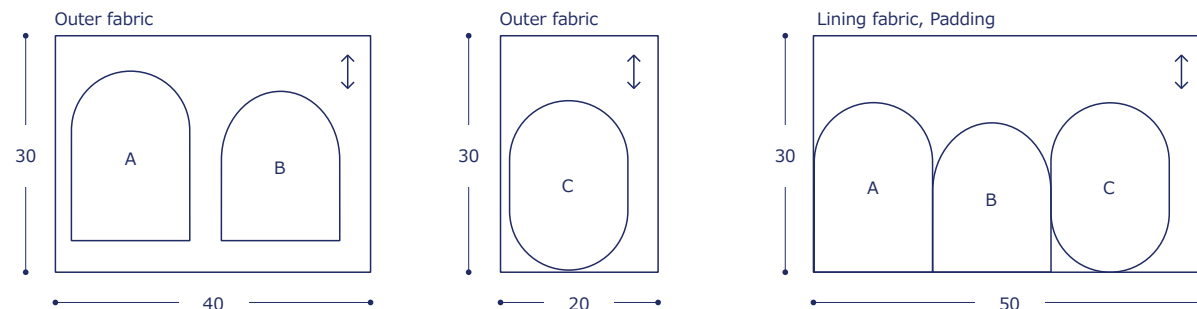
Pattern

*All measurements are in centimeters (cm). Enlarge it to the designated size.



Cutting Layout

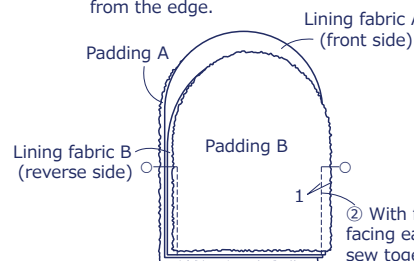
All edges are left cut



Instructions

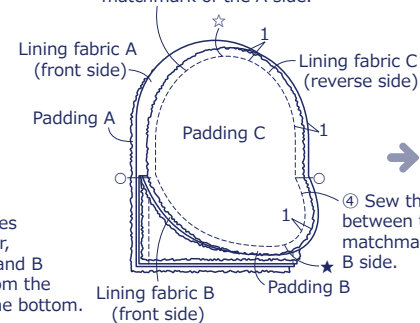
1. Make the lining mitt.

① Layer the padding on the reverse side of the lining fabric. Baste around it at 0.5cm from the edge.



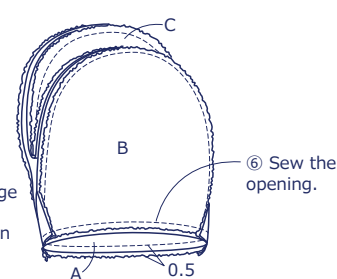
② With front sides facing each other, sew together A and B lining fabrics from the matchmark to the bottom. (Place a folded tape (8cm) on one side.)

③ With front sides facing each other, sew together the lining fabric from ② and lining fabric C from one end of the matchmark of the A side.



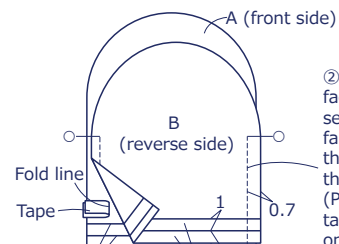
④ Sew the edge between the matchmarks on B side.

⑤ Cut off the seam from ② - ④ for 0.5cm.



⑥ Sew the opening.

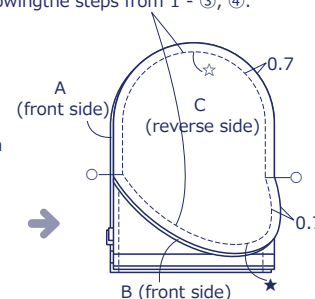
2. Make the outer mitt.



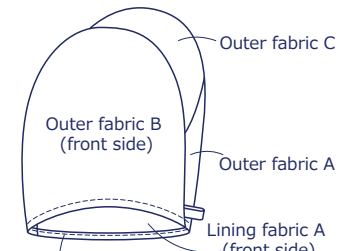
② With front sides facing each other, sew together outer fabrics A and B from the matchmark to the bottom. (Place a folded tape (8cm) on one side.)

① Double fold the opening of both outer fabrics A and B, front side facing outside. Iron to score.

③ With front sides facing each other, layer ② and C and sew together following the steps from 1 - ③, ④.



3. Sew together the outer mitt and lining mitt.



With front sides facing outside, sew together the outer mitt and lining mitt. Double fold the end (bottom opening) inward to wrap the edge of the lining mitt and sew to finish.
