



Square Bag with Straight Handles

Size: 23cm (l) x 32cm (w) x 4cm (d)

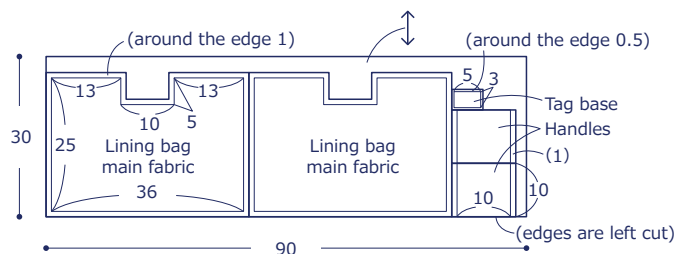
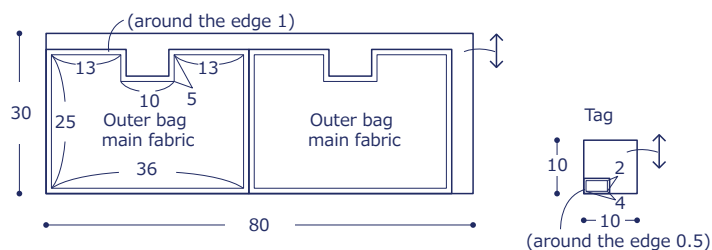
Materials (for one bag)

- Fabric (Outer bag main fabric): 80cm×30cm
(Lining bag main fabric, Handles, Tag base (canvas)): 90cm×30cm
(Tag (Print)): 10cm×10cm
- Fusible quilt batting: 80cm×30cm

Fabric shown for this sample: (Outer bag main fabric) törten JG49100-1(C)

Pattern and Cutting Layout

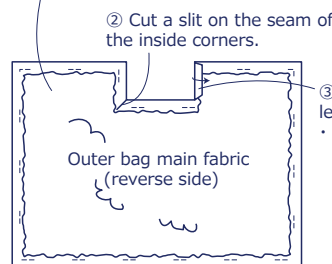
All measurements are in centimeters (cm).
Cut the fabric with seam allowance in ().



Instructions

1. Prepare the opening of the bags.

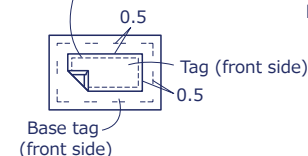
① Adhere fusible quilt batting to the back of the outer bag main fabric. (Place it within the seam line)



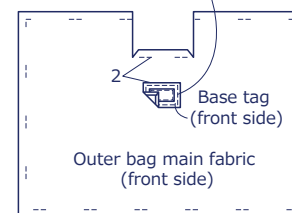
*Repeat the same process as Step 1-②&③ for Lining bag's main fabrics. (Make two pieces)

2. Make a tag.

① Fold the seam of the tag and sew it onto the base tag fabric.

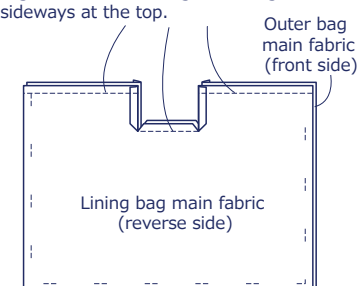


② Fold the seam of the tag and sew it to one of the outer fabrics.

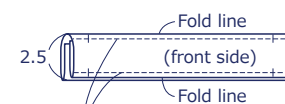


3. Sew together the outer bag and lining bags at the top opening.

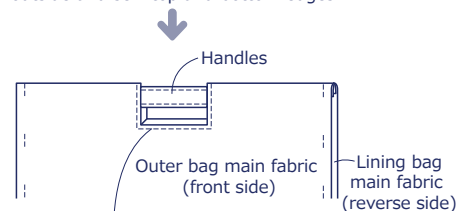
With front sides facing each other, sew together the outer bag and lining bag sideways at the top.



4. Make the handles.



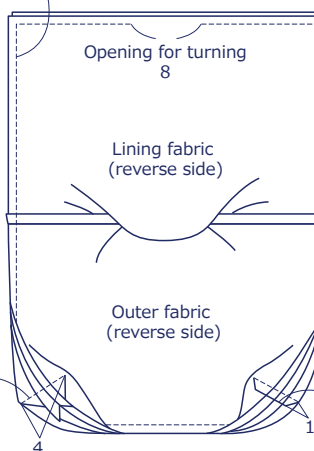
① Fold the handles in four with outer side facing outside and sew top and bottom edges.



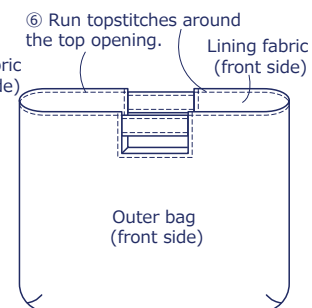
② Turn the bag inside out, place the handle in-between and sew the center.
• Make two pieces.

5. Complete the bag.

① With front sides facing each other, sew together outer and lining bags all the way around leaving an opening for turning.



⑤ Turn it inside out and close the opening.



④ Make a gusset and sew on the lining bag as in Step 5-②&③.

③ Cut off the excess seam.

② Fold the bottom in triangle to make a gusset and sew.
