



Bag and Pouch Set Made with only 1.2m of Fabric

Design & work: Kokka Fabric

Size: Bag about 22cm (l) x 32cm (w) x 12cm (d)
Pouch about 16cm (l) x 20cm (w)

Materials

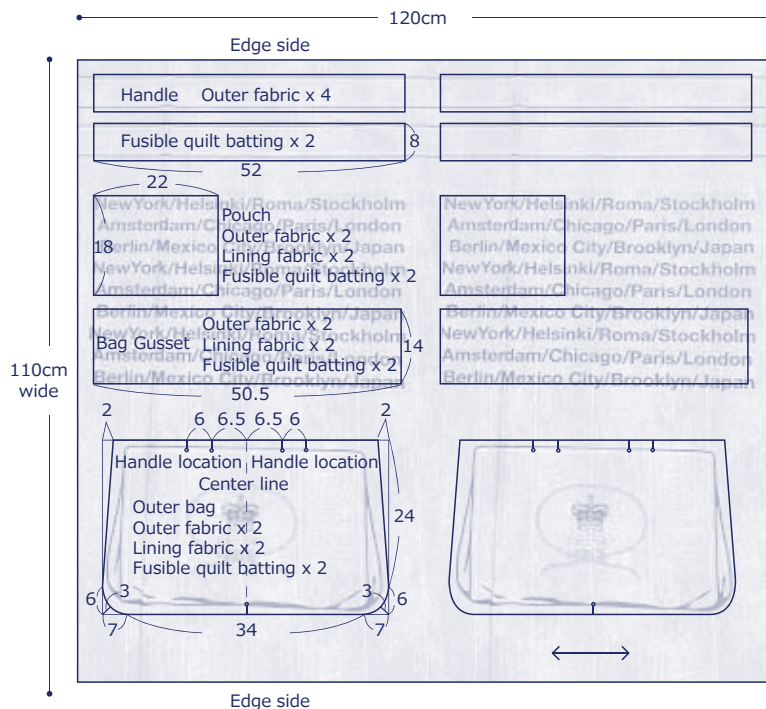
- Outer Fabric 110cm wide × 120cm
- Lining Fabric 110cm wide x 60cm
- Fusible Quilt Batting 100cm wide × 80cm
- Flat Knit Zipper 20cm long x 1

Fabric shown for this sample: P36500-500(C)

Pattern and Cutting Layout

All measurements are in centimeters (cm). Includes seam allowance.

* Attach fusible quilt batting to the back of the outer fabric.



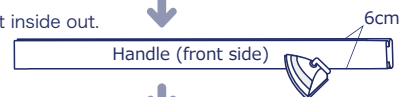
Instructions

1. Make the handles and attach them temporarily to the outer bag.

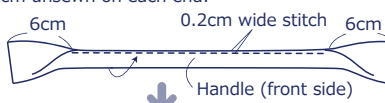
- ① With front sides facing each other, run stitches on the top and bottom of the handles at 1cm from the edge.



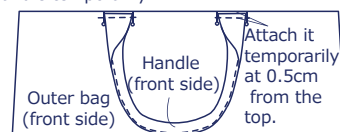
- ② Turn it inside out.



- ③ Fold the handle in half. Run stitches at the top, leaving 6cm unsewn on each end.



- ④ Using the mark on the outer bag as a guide, attach the handle temporarily.



* Repeat the process for the other handle.

2. With front sides facing each other, sew together the gusset.

- Sew at 1cm.



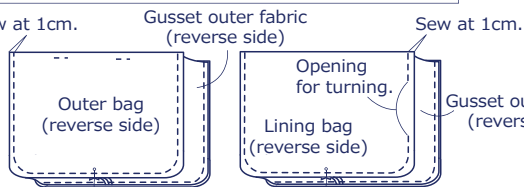
- Press the seam open using an iron.



Repeat the process for gusset lining fabric.

3. With front sides facing each other, sew together the bag fabrics and gusset.

- Sew at 1cm.

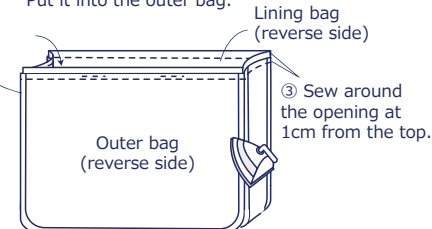


Align the sew line of the gusset and center of the outer bag where it's marked.

4. With front sides facing each other, sew together the outer and lining bags.

- ① Press the seam open.

- ② Turn the lining bag inside out.
Put it into the outer bag.

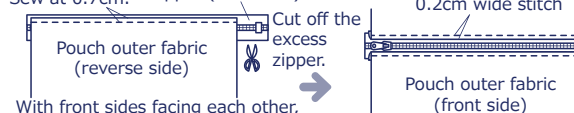


5. Turn the bag inside out and close the opening for turning. Run top stitches around the opening to finish!



6. Attach a zipper on the outer fabric of the pouch.

- Sew at 0.7cm. Zipper (front side)

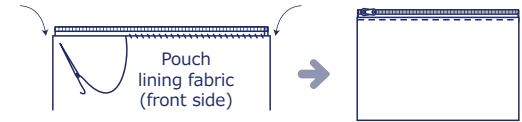


With front sides facing each other, sew together the outer fabric and zipper at 0.7cm from the edge.

7. With front sides facing each other, sew the sides and bottom of pouch's outer and lining fabrics.



8. Attach the lining bag to the outer bag, stitching onto the zipper.



Sew together the pouch lining bag and zipper using blind stitches.

Turn it inside out to finish!
