



Round Tote Bag

Design & work: Kokka Fabric

Size: about 23cm (l) (up to the opening) x 30.5cm (w) x 9cm (d)

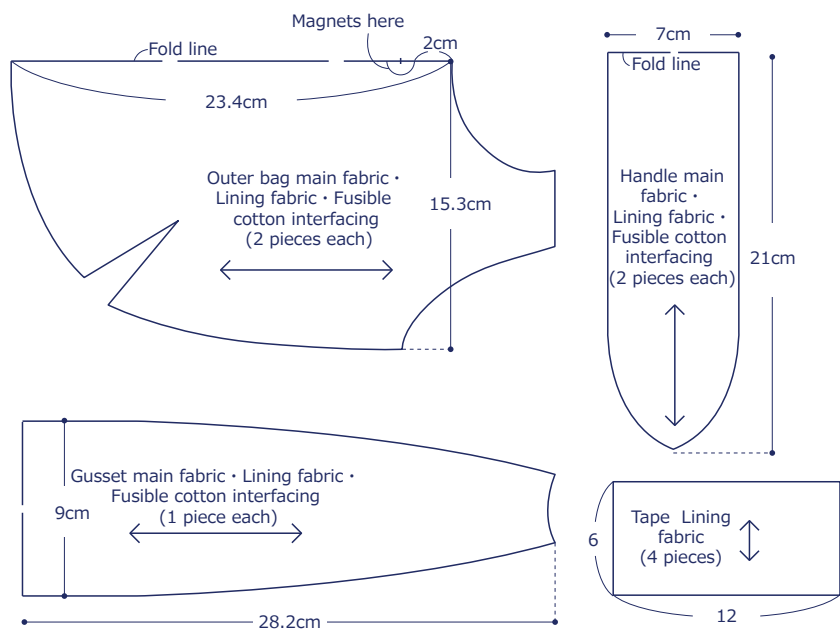
Materials (for one bag)

- Outer fabric (double gauze): 106cm wide x 70cm
- Lining fabric: 110cm wide x 70cm
- Fusible cotton interfacing: 100cm wide x 70cm
- Fusible interfacing: 2.5cm square x 2
- Magnet button: One pair

Fabric shown for this sample: P35500-503 (D)

Round Tote Bag Pattern (Enlarge it to 400%)

*All seam allowances are 1cm. Add the seam allowance when cutting the fabric.



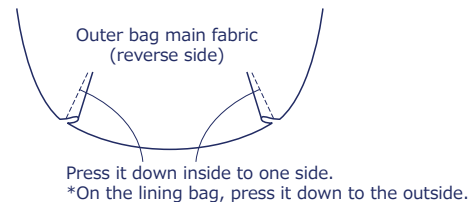
*The measurement includes seam allowance.

*Pattern for the tape is not included.
Cut the fabric with straight lines.

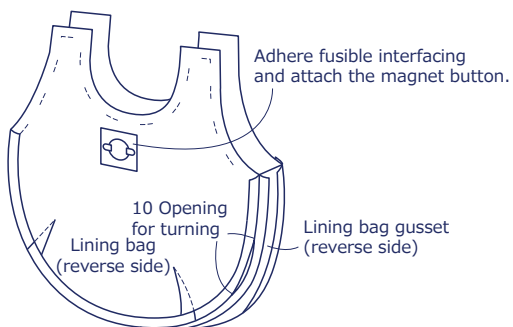
Instructions

1. Attach fusible cotton interfacing to the outer bag main fabric and gusset.

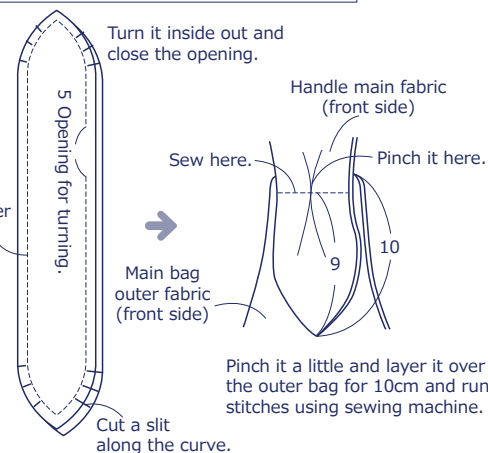
2. Sew darts.



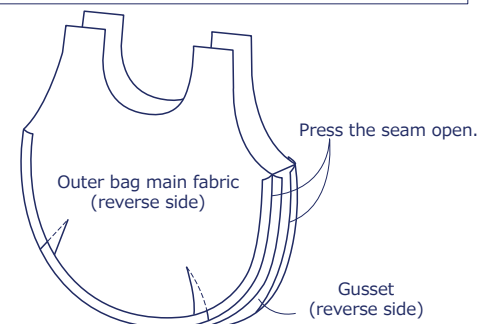
4. Sew the lining bag, leaving an opening for turning. Attach the magnet button.



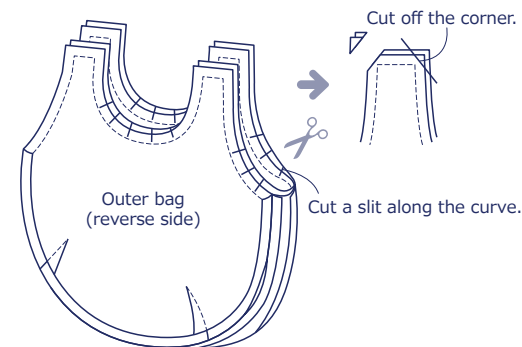
6. Make the handles and attach them to the bag.



3. With front sides facing each other, sew together the outer bag main fabric and gusset to make a bag.



5. With front sides facing each other, layer the outer bag and lining bag. Sew together at the top opening. Turn it inside out and close the opening.



7. Using same fabric for the lining fabric, make a 2cm wide tape. Fold the edge for 1cm, layer and attach it over the handle sewn in Step 6.
