Size: 35.5cm (l) 30cm (w—at the top) 12cm (d)

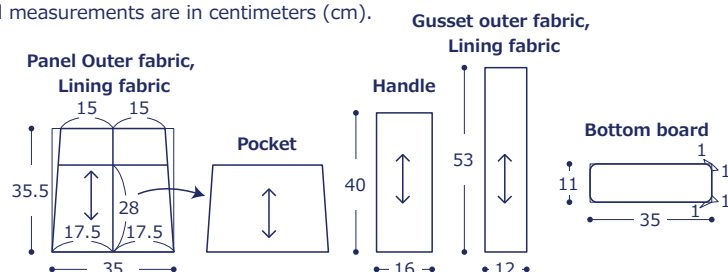
Materials

- Fabric (Panel, Gusset): 80cm×130cm
(Pocket, Handle): 40cm x 110cm wide
- Fusible quilt batting: 60cm x 80cm
- Bottom board for the bag: 35cm x 15cm
- Snap: 2 pairs (1cm diameter)

Fabric shown for this sample: Lisa Grue JG50300-301(D)

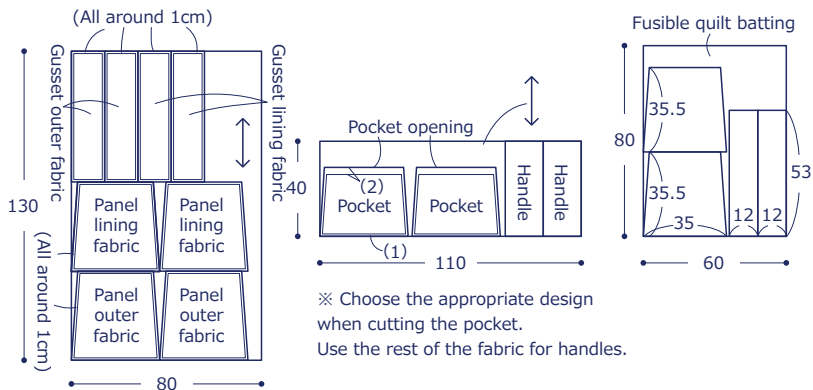
Pattern

All measurements are in centimeters (cm).



Cutting Layout

Numbers in () denote seam allowance. Edges are left cut unless otherwise stated. Edge of the bottom board is left cut.

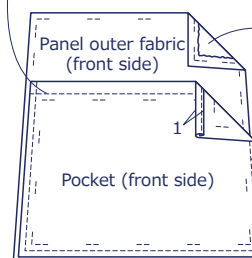

Instructions

1. Make the pocket.

①Double fold the pocket opening and sew.



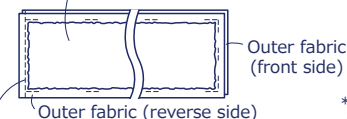
②Attach the fusible quilt batting to the panel outer fabric.

③Baste the pocket to panel outer fabric.

*Make two pieces.

2. Make the gusset.

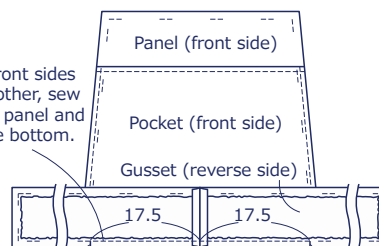
①Attach the fusible quilt batting to outer fabric.
*Make two pieces.



②With the front sides facing each other, put together the outer fabrics and sew the short side.

*Repeat the process ② for lining fabric.

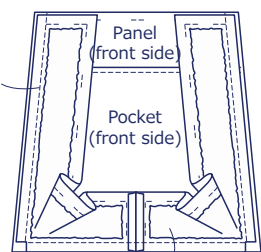
3. Make the outer bag.



①With the front sides facing each other, sew together the panel and gusset at the bottom.

② Cut a slit on the seam of the gusset.

③Sew both sides.



Gusset (reverse side)

4. Make the lining bag.

As in Step 3, repeat the process. (Leave an opening for turning for 18cm on one side.)

5. Make the handles.

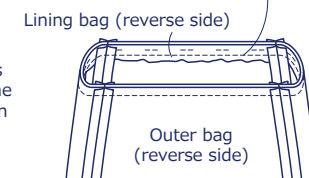
Handle (front side)



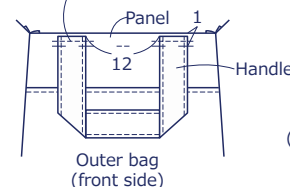
①With the front sides facing outside, fold the handle in four and run stitches.
*Make two pieces.

6. Sew together the outer bag and lining bag.

①With the front sides facing each other, sew together the outer and lining bags.



②Baste the handle to the outer bag.



*Attach the handle on the other panel.

④Repeat the process ①~③ for the other panel fabric and gusset.

②Turn it inside out and close the opening. Run top stitches.
