



Tote Bag with a Mini Pouch

Size: Bag 32.5cm (l – center of the panel)
44cm (w) 14cm (d)
Mini pouch 7cm (each side)

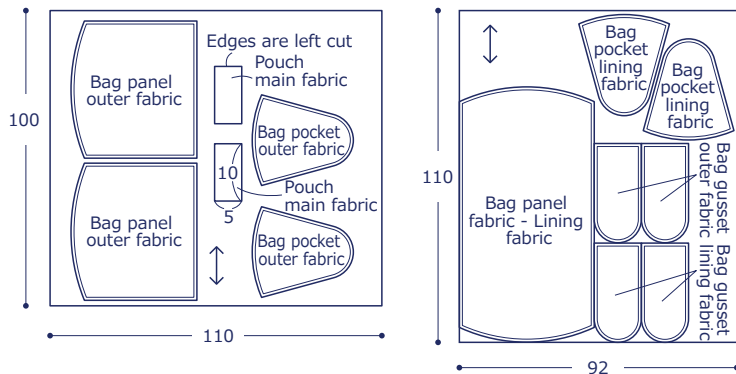
Materials

- Fabric (Bag outer panel, pocket outer fabric, pouch main fabric): 110cm wide × 100cm (Bag gusset outer fabric, lining fabric) (#11 Canvas): 92cm wide × 110cm
- Fusible interfacing (thick): 50cmx100cm
- Rope: 160cm (1.5cm diameter)
- Cord: 0.3cm wide x 30cm
- Magnetic clasps (hook type): 1 pair (1.8cm diameter)
- Plastic eyelets: 4 pairs (5cm outer diameter, 2.5cm inner diameter)
- Zipper 1 piece (10cm)

Fabric shown for this sample: Törten CINEMA JG49200-1 (A)

Pattern and Cutting Layout

All measurements are in centimeters (cm).
Add 1cm seam allowances unless otherwise stated.



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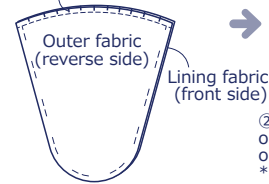
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Instructions

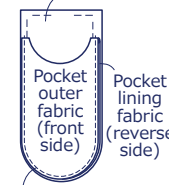
<Bag>

1. Make the pocket.

① With front sides facing each other, sew together the pocket opening. Cut a slit on the seam.

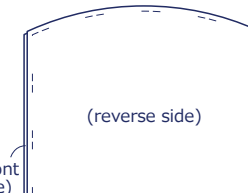


Gusset outer fabric (front side)



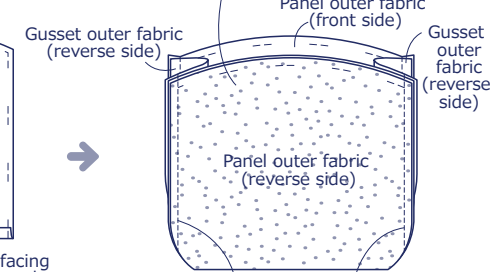
② Turn the pocket inside out. Baste it to the gusset outer fabric.
*Make two pieces.

2. Make the outer bag.



① With the front sides facing each other, sew together the bottom of the panel outer fabrics. Press the seam open.

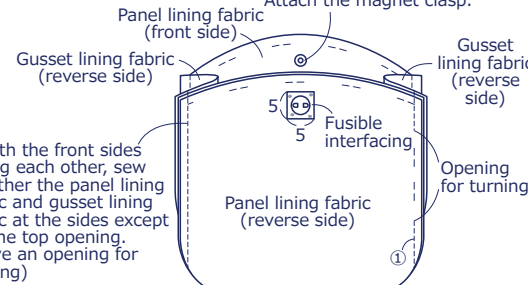
② Adhere interfacing to the panel outer fabric.



③ With the front sides facing each other, sew together the panel outer fabric and gusset outer fabric at the sides except for the top opening.

3. Make the lining bag.

② Adhere interfacing to the magnetic clasp location. Attach the magnet clasp.



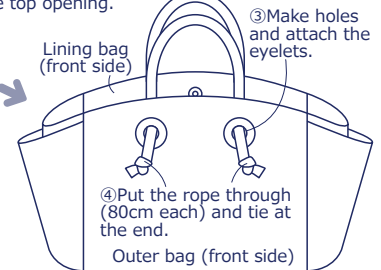
① With the front sides facing each other, sew together the panel lining fabric and gusset lining fabric at the sides except for the top opening. (leave an opening for turning)

4. Sew together the outer bag and lining bag.

① With the front sides facing each other, sew together the outer and lining bags at the top opening.

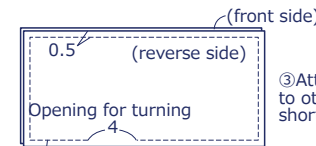


② Turn it inside out and close the opening for turning.

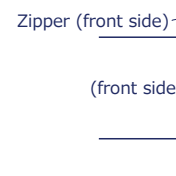


③ Make holes and attach the eyelets.
④ Put the rope through (80cm each) and tie at the end.
⑤ Outer bag (front side)

<Pouch>

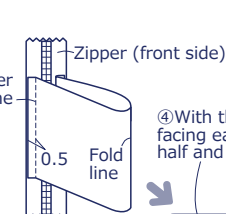


① With the front sides facing each other, sew together the fabrics, leaving an opening for turning.

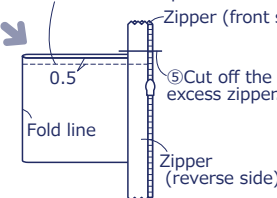


② Turn it inside out and attach the zipper to the short side.

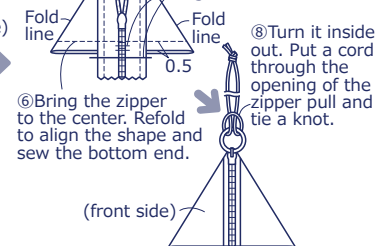
Align the side end of the zipper and short end of the fabric.



④ With the front sides facing each other, fold in half and sew the top end.



⑦ Cut off the excess zipper and secure the edge.



⑧ Turn it inside out. Put a cord through the opening of the zipper pull and tie a knot.
