








1. Make the bag body.


Instructions

① With the front sides facing each other, sew together the sides (up to the opening) and bottom of the outer fabrics to make the outer bag.




② Using the same process as in ①, make the lining bag.

③ With the front sides facing each other, sew together the bags from ①&② on the sides starting from the opening to the top.




3 Fold the edge of the handle portion

3. Finish the bag.


① Turn the bag inside out.
