
Size: 20cm (I – when folded) 27cm (w-bottom) 2cm (d)

### Instructions

#### 1. Make the outer bag




(front side)

Put the tape (5cm) through rectangle buckle and fold in half. Apply zigzag stitches.

· Make two pieces.

### ☐ Tape: 1.4m (3cm wide)☐ Lobster clasp, Rectangle

**Materials** 

□ Lobster clasp, Rectangle buckle: 2 pieces each (3cm inner diameter)

□ Adjustable slide buckle: 1 piece (3cm inner diameter)

□ Fabric (Outer fabric) : 70cm wide × 30cm


(Lining fabric): 40cm wide × 70cm


(Bottom fabric): 40cm wide × 20cm


Fabric shown for this sample: (Outer fabric) Ellen Baker EKXA-5200-2A

### **Pattern and Cutting Layout**

Unit: Centimeters (cm) All raw edge.







### 2. Make the lining bag

With the front sides facing each other, fold the lining fabric in half. Repeat the process as in  $\boxed{1}$ - $\boxed{3}$  (no tape) and  $\boxed{4}$ .

### 3. Sew together the outer bag and lining bag

3 With the front sides

facing each other,


2 in-between and

sew both sides.


fold ① in half. Place

(reverse side)

Fold the edge of the outer bag and lining bag for 1cm inward. With the front sides facing outside, sew together the bags.



#### 4. Make the strap



- (1) Put the tape (1.3m) through lobster clasp and adjustable slide buckle and sew.
- ② Attach it to the bag.
