




Pattern

Unit: cm. All seam allowance - 1cm. Add seam allowance when cutting the fabric.

Zipper gusset (A) Fabric x 2 Fusible interfacing x 2

® Outer fabric x 1® Lining fabric x 1

① Adhere fusible interfacing on the back of the Zipper gusset, Opening transition fabric and Outer bag fabric.

Instructions

② Sew together the opening transition fabric and outer bag fabric. Make the handle and baste it to the bag fabric.


Baste at 0.5cm from the edge. Center 4.5cm wide flat tape 30cm cut x 2 Stitch at 0.2cm from the edge. 0.2 Opening Outer bag fabric transition fabric (front side) (front side) Fusible interfacing Fold only the center of the 4.5cm wide flat tape in half. Apply stitches to hold.

3 Sew together the sides of the outer bag and lining bag respectively.




Lining bag fabric (reverse side) Leave for tur 13cm.

Sew together the bag fabric and bottom fabric
 (Repeat the process for lining fabrics).



⑤ Apply zigzag stitches around the zipper gusset and piece together with the zipper.



6 Sew the side of the zipper gusset.

Sew at 1cm

Fold for 1cm. Fusible interfacing from the edge.

® Turn it inside out using the opening for turning on the lining fabric. Align the shape of the top opening using an iron. Sew the zipper gusset in line with the top opening.
※ Close the opening for turning on the lining fabric.
