Design & Work: Kokka Fabric

Size: about 48cm (I) about 51cm (w) (excludes handles)

Materials


- □ Outer Fabric: about 110cm wide x 70cm
- □ Lining Fabric: about 110cm wide x 50cm
- ☐ Fusible Interfacing (medium weight): 6cm wide x 3cm
- ☐ Magnetic Hook: about 15mm wide x One pair

Fabric shown for this sample: YPA-46030-1E

Pattern & Cutting Layout

Unit: cm []: Seam Allowance

Add 1cm seam when cutting the fabric unless otherwise specified.





Instructions Front Side - (FrS), Reverse Side (RvS)


1. Score the bag opening of the outer bag fabric



*Repeat the same process on the other piece.


2. Attach the magnetic hook on the outer bag fabric


Adhere the reinforcement fabric on the back side and attach the magnetic hook (凸).




hook (凹) on the other piece. (FrS)


3. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the bag fabrics at the sides and bottom





4. With the front sides facing each other, layer bag fabrics and sew together at the top opening





6. Make the handle and attach it to the outer bag fabric to finish
