

Drawstring Bag with Ruffles

Design & work: Kokka Fabric

Size: about 43cm (I) about 30cm (w) (bag portion only)

Materials

- □ Outer Fabric: 110cm wide x 100cm
- □ Lining Fabric: 110cm wide x 50cm
- ☐ Fusible Interfacing (For Lining):

110cm wide x 70cm



Cutting Layout





Opening Fabric for Drawstring Outer Fabric x 2





Instructions Front Side - (FrS), Reverse Side (RvS)


1. Adhere fusible interfacing on the back of the handle. Make two pieces each of handle and drawstring



2. Make the ruffles


①Sew together the bottom center of the ruffles. With the front sides facing each other,

sew together the ends of the piece and apply stitches.




3. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the body outer fabric and lining fabric around the perimeter


①Adhere fusible interfacing on the back of the body outer fabric. Baste the ruffles below the matchmark and sew together along the perimeter.




①With the front sides facing each other, sew together the body lining fabric around the perimeter and leave an opening for turning.




4. Make the opening fabric for drawstring



5. Sew together the top opening of the body outer fabric and lining fabric



6. Attach the drawstring opening fabric to the bag opening



7. Insert the drawstring through the opening to finish
