



Lined Zipper Pouch

Design & work: Yui Tamaki

Size: about 12cm (l)
about 21cm (w – at opening) 11cm (bottom)
10cm (gusset)

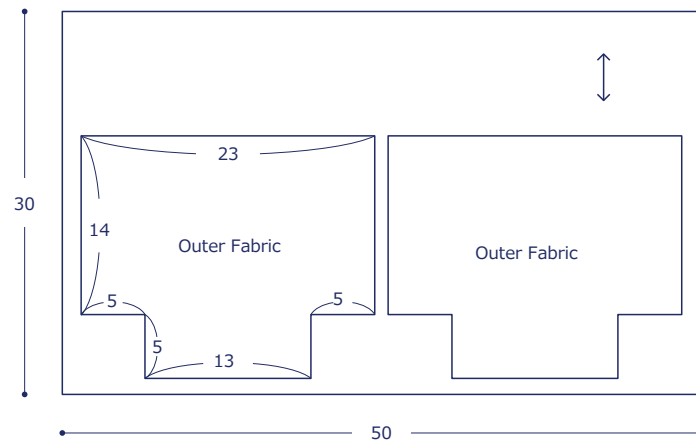
Material

- Fabric (Outer Fabric): 50cm x 30cm
(Lining Fabric (Sheeting)): 50cm x 30cm
- Fusible Interfacing (medium weight)(Presion Interfacing Harihari):
50cm x 30cm
- Zipper: 20cm x one piece

Fabric shown for this sample: YK-29010-3B

Pattern and Cutting Layout

Unit: cm All raw edge.
Adhere fusible interfacing on the back of the outer fabric.
Mark and cut along the cutting line.
Cut two pieces of outer and lining fabrics each with the same measurement.



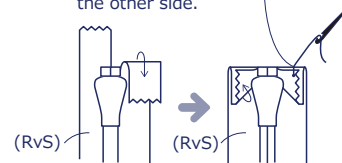
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Instructions Front Side - (FrS), Reverse Side - (RvS)

1. Finish the zipper end

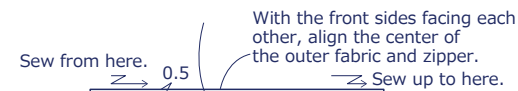
Fold as shown and sew to secure.
• Repeat the same process on the other side.



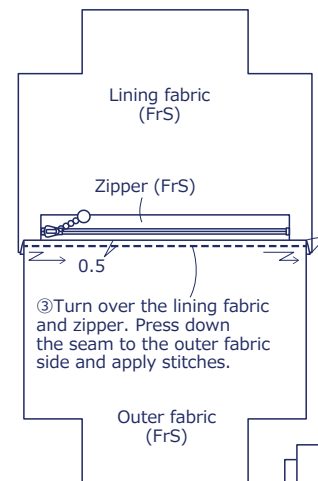
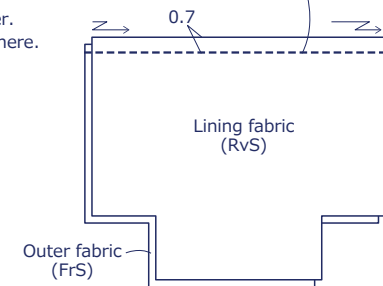
2. Make the body

☆Apply back stitches at the start and end of the stitch.

① Set the sewing machine's presser foot to "zipper presser foot". With the front sides facing each other, sew together the outer fabric and zipper.



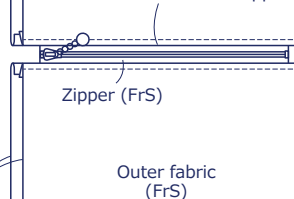
② With the front sides facing each other, sew together the piece from ① and lining fabric, as you adjust the zipper slider.



③ Turn over the lining fabric and zipper. Press down the seam to the outer fabric side and apply stitches.



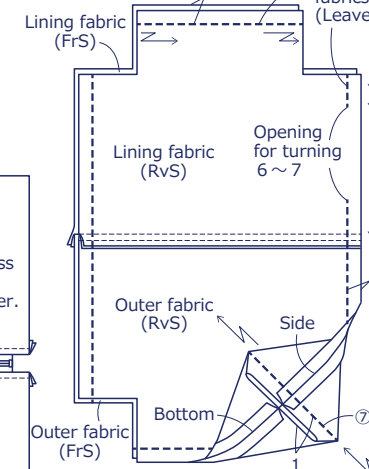
⑤ Repeat the same process as in steps ①~④ for the other side of the zipper.



④ With the front sides facing outside, put together the outer and lining fabrics.

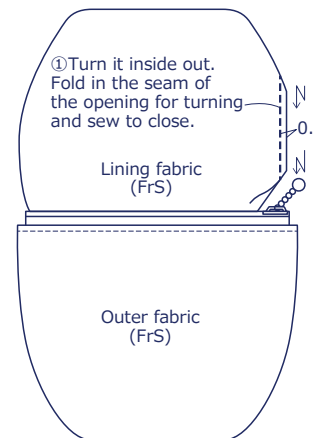


⑥ Switch the sewing machine's presser foot to regular presser foot. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the outer and lining fabrics at the sides and bottom respectively. (Leave an opening for turning on one side.)



3. Finish the bag

① Turn it inside out. Fold in the seam of the opening for turning and sew to close.



⑦ Press the seam open and sew the gusset.
• Repeat the same process on the outer and lining fabrics in two locations respectively.

② Align the shape.
