38cm (bottom) 10cm (gusset)

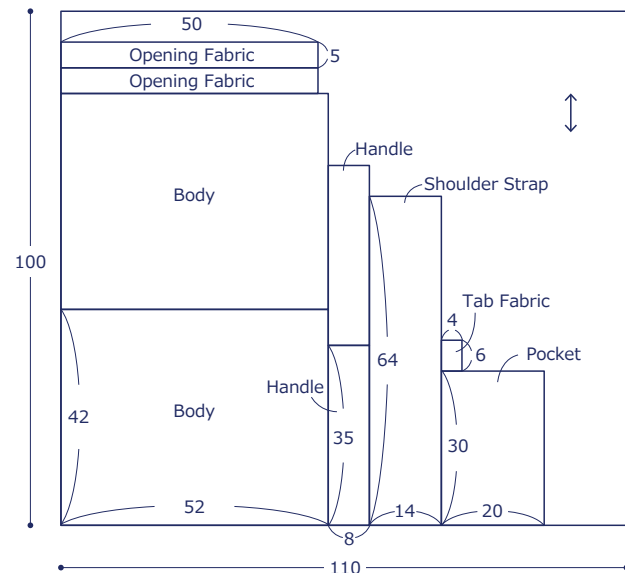
Materials

- Fabric: 110cm wide x 1m
- Swivel Hook: 1.1cm inner diameter x One piece

Fabric shown for this sample: EKX-91000-101B

Pattern and Cutting Layout

Unit: cm All raw edge



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Instructions Front Side - (FrS), Reverse Side (RvS)

1. Make the tab

① With the front sides facing outside, fold in four and sew.

② Insert through a swivel hook, fold in half and baste the attachment side.

2. Make the pocket

① With the front sides facing each other, fold the pocket in half. Place the tab in-between and sew together, leaving an opening for turning.

② Cut off corner seams.

③ Turn the pocket inside out and apply stitches at the top opening.

④ Attach it to the body.

3. Sew the bottom

① With the front sides facing each other, put the body pieces together and sew the bottom. Cut the seam of one of the pieces.

② Fold the seam and wrap this seam with the other seam.

③ Press down the seam and sew.

4. Sew the side and gusset

① With the front sides facing each other, fold the body in half and sew the sides.

② Cut a slit on the seam.

③ Cut off the seam of one side as shown.

④ Repeat the same process as in Step ③ ② ③.

⑤ Sew the gusset.

⑥ Cut off the seam as shown.

⑦ Fold the seam in three and sew.

• Repeat the same process on the other side.

5. Make the handle, shoulder strap and opening fabric

<Handle>

① With the front sides facing outside, fold in four and sew. • Make two pieces.

<Shoulder Strap>

① With the front sides facing each other, fold in half and sew.

② Turn it inside out. Slide the stitch line from ① to the center and apply stitches.

<Opening Fabric>

With the front sides facing each other, sew together the two pieces at both sides and press the seam open.

② Fold the edge of the opening fabric.

6. Finish the bag

① With the front sides facing each other, sew together the body and opening fabric, with the handle and shoulder strap placed in-between.

③ Turn over the opening fabric and apply stitches.
