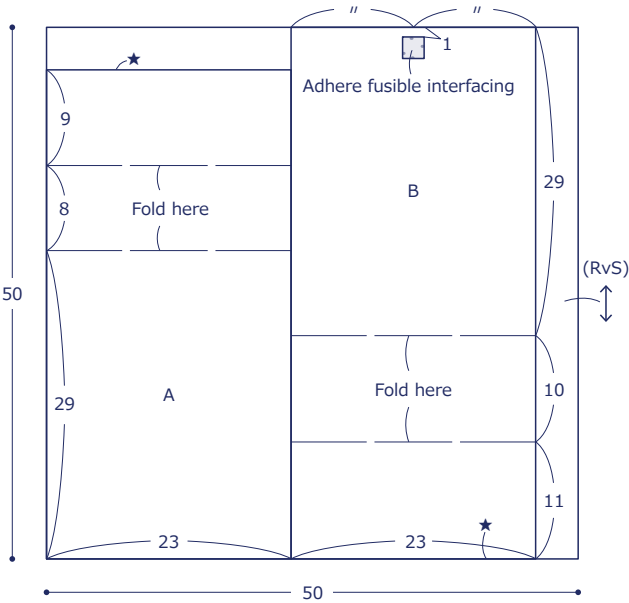
Materials

- Fabric: 50cm x 50cm
- Fusible Interfacing: 2cm x 2cm
- Plasnap Button: One pair (1.1cm diameter)

Fabric shown for this sample: EKX-1700-1A

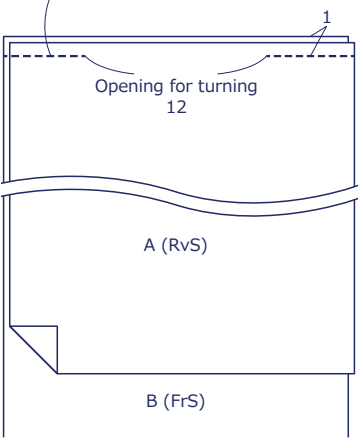
Pattern and Cutting Layout

Unit: cm. All raw edge.

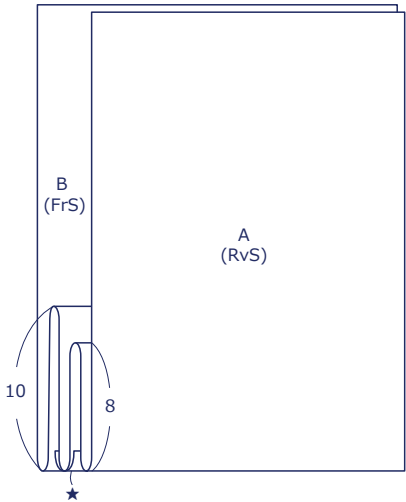


Instructions Front Side - (FrS), Reverse Side (RvS)

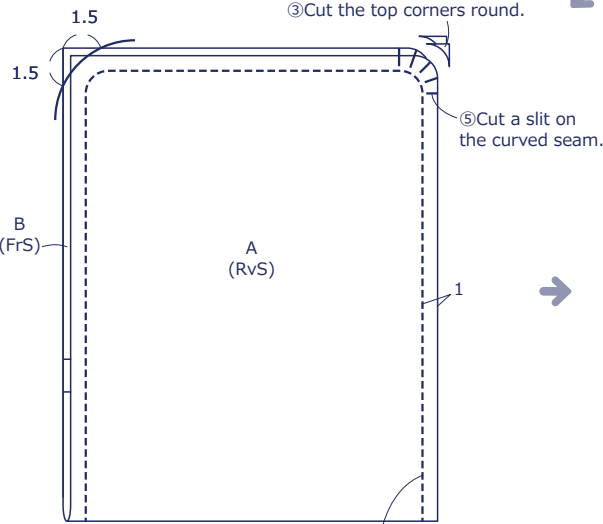
① With the front sides facing each other, sew together the fabrics A and B, matching ★, leaving an opening for turning.



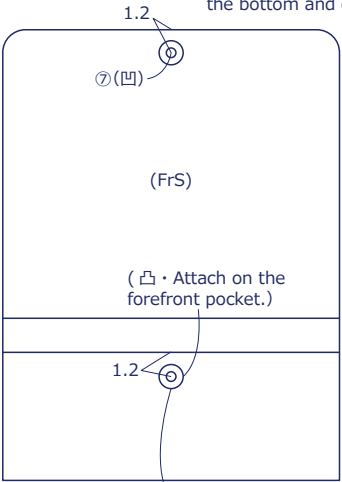
② Press the seam from ① open, and fold as shown.



③ Cut the top corners round.



⑥ Turn the case inside out from the bottom and close the opening.



④ Sew the sides except for the bottom.

⑦ Attach the Plasnap.
