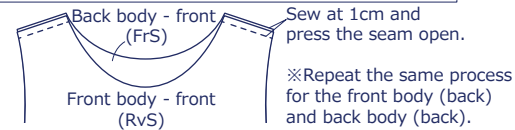

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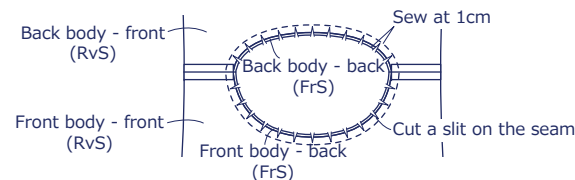
Instructions

Front Side - (FrS), Reverse Side - (RvS)

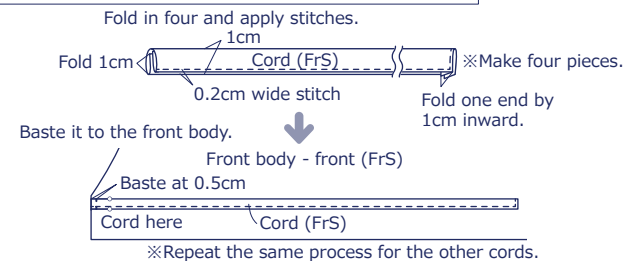
1. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the front body and back body at the shoulder



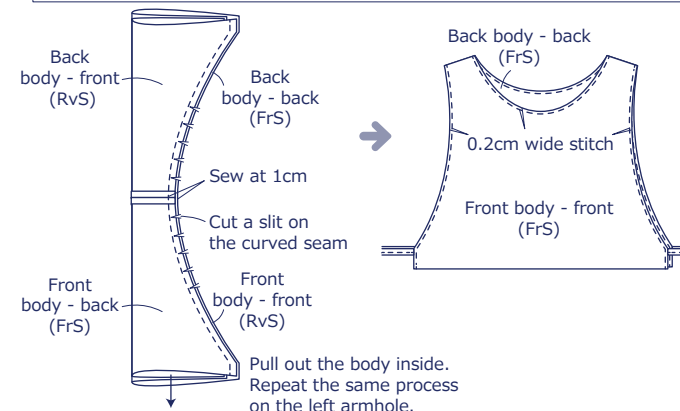
2. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the front body and back body at the neckline



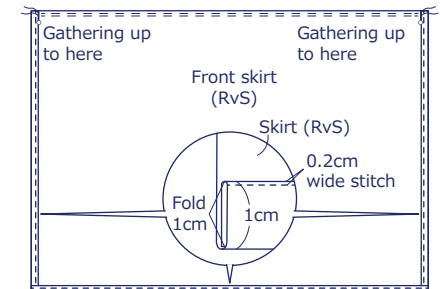
3. Make the cord and baste it to the front body



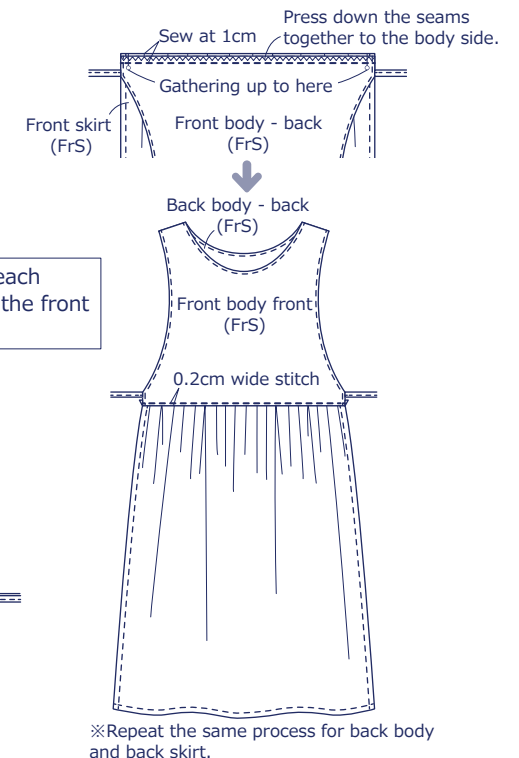
4. Turn the body to the front side. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the bodies around the armhole. Turn it to the front side, and apply stitches around the neckline and armhole



5. Fold the side and hem of the skirt in three. Apply stitches and gather the waist



6. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the front body and skirt. Apply stitches around the waist to finish



Materials

□ Outer Fabric: approx. 100cm wide x 250cm

Fabric shown for this sample: YGA-86030-1B
