<C> 28cm (l) 18cm (w)

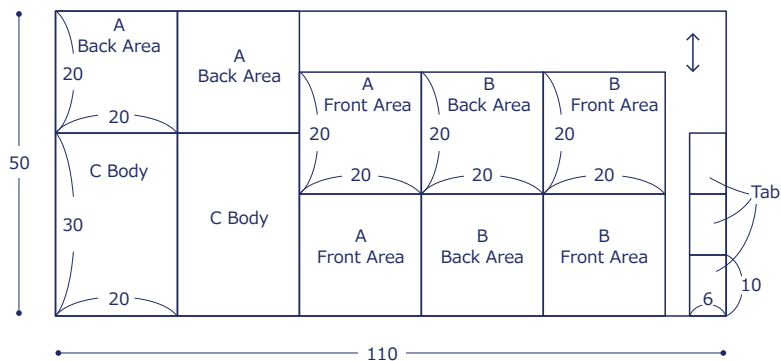
Materials

- Fabric: 110cm wide x 50cm
- Fusible Quilt Batting: 60cm x 40cm
- Fusible Interfacing: 40cm x 20cm

Fabric shown for this sample: EKX-98140-1A

Pattern & Cutting Layout

Unit: cm All raw edge



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Instructions

<A>

- ① Adhere fusible quilt batting on the back area and fusible interfacing on the front area.
- ② Cut to a circle (20cm diameter).
- ③ Make the tab.
 - a. With the front sides facing outside, fold the tab in four and sew.
 - b. Fold the tab in half and baste it to the back area.
- ④ With the front sides facing outside, fold the front area in half and apply stitches. • Make two pieces.
- ⑤ Layer each part as shown.
- ⑥ Leaving an opening for turning, sew as shown.
- ⑦ Cut a slit along the seam.
- ⑧ Turn it inside out and close the opening for turning.

- ① Repeat the same process as in <A> ① and ③a.
- ② Fold the tab in half and baste it on the back area.
- ③ With the front sides facing outside, fold the front area piece in half and apply stitches. • Make two pieces.
- ④ Layer each part as shown and sew together, leaving an opening for turning.
- ⑤ Cut off the corner seam.
- ⑥ Turn it inside out and close the opening for turning.

<C>

- ① Adhere fusible quilt batting on one piece.
- ② Fold the tab in half and baste it in the center.
- ③ With the front sides facing each other, put together two pieces and sew together, leaving an opening for turning.
- ④ Cut off the corner seam.
- ⑥ Turn it inside out, fold in the seam around the opening and apply stitches.
