



Lunch Tote Bag

Design & work: Kokka Fabric

Size: approx. 18.5cm (l)
 approx. 36cm (w)
 approx. 15cm (gusset)
 (excluding handles)


Materials

- Outer Fabric: approx. 110cm wide x 80cm
- Fusible Quilt Batting: approx. 90cm wide x 60cm
- Bias Binding Tape: 8mm wide x 110cm

Fabric shown for this sample: YGA-89000-1A

Pattern

Unit: cm [] : denotes seam allowance
 Add 1cm seam allowance unless otherwise stated.



※Adhere fusible interfacing on the back of the outer bag fabric.






Instructions Front Side - (FrS), Reverse Side (RvS)

1. Baste the outer bag fabric and lining bag fabric



2. Make the handles and baste them to the facing



※Repeat the same process for the other pair.

3. Make the facing


Apply zigzag stitches on side seams.




With the front sides facing each other, sew both sides. Sew at 1.5cm and press the seam open.




Fold in three and apply stitches.



4. Finish the side seams with the bias binding tape




5. With the front sides facing each other, fold the bottom of the outer fabric, then sew the sides.



6. Sew together the bag fabric and facing

With the front sides facing each other, put together the lining bag fabric and facing, then sew.



7. Turn it inside out and align the shape to finish
