



# Fluffy Bag

Size: 25cm (l) 54cm (w-opening side)  
20cm (bottom) 10cm gusset

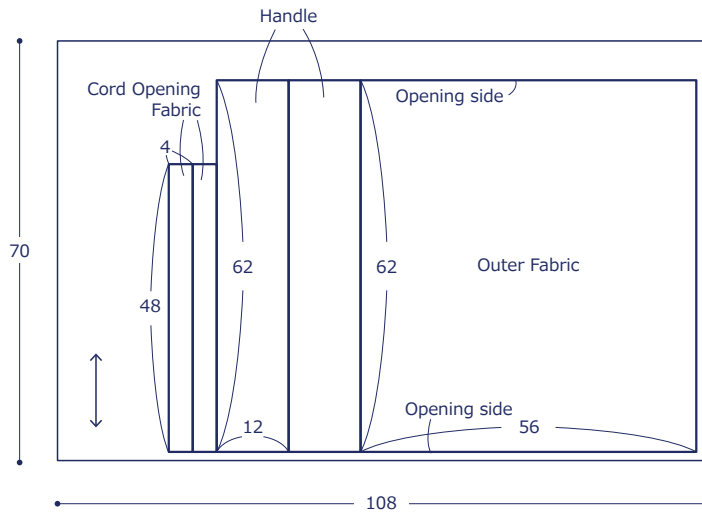
## Materials

- Fabric (Outer Fabric, Handle, Cord Opening Fabric): 108cm wide x 70cm (Lining Fabric): 56cm x 62cm
- Quilt Batting: 56cm x 62cm
- Waxed Cord: 0.3cm diameter x 2.4m

Fabric shown for this sample: EKX-150-1B

## Pattern and Cutting Layout

Unit: cm All raw edge



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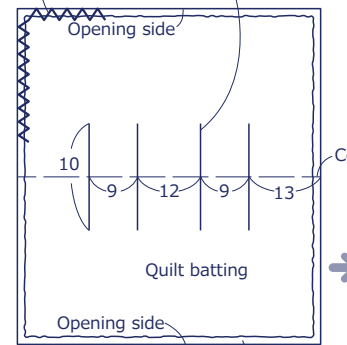
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## Instructions Front Side - (FrS), Reverse Side (RvS)

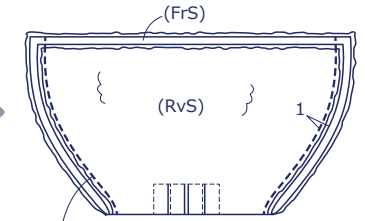
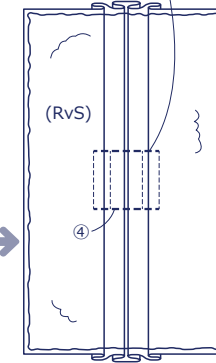
### 1. Make the outer bag

① Layer the quilt batting and baste with zigzag stitches.

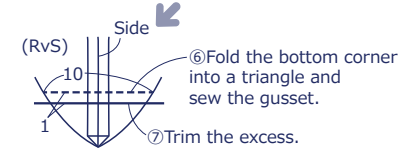
② Mark the fold line for the tuck.



④ Sew the remaining three tucks in the same way as in step ③, then fold them inward and sew them in place at the top and bottom.



⑤ With the front sides facing each other, fold in half and sew both sides.



⑥ Fold the bottom corner into a triangle and sew the gusset.

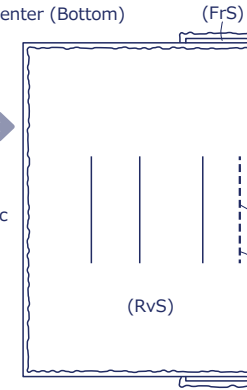
⑦ Trim the excess.



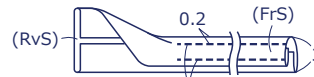
⑧ Apply zigzag stitches on the seam allowance. Repeat the same process on the other side.

### 2. Make the lining bag

Using the lining fabric, repeat the same process as in ①-② through ⑤ (leaving a 10cm opening on one side for turning) and steps ⑥ through ⑧.



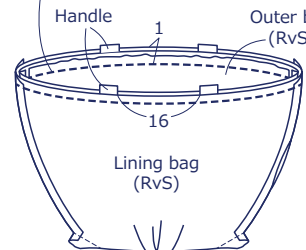
### 3. Make the handles



With the front sides facing outside, fold in four and sew.  
• Make two pieces.

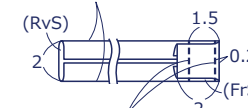
### 4. Make the body

① With the front sides facing each other, put together the outer bag and lining bag and sew together at the top opening with the handles in between.

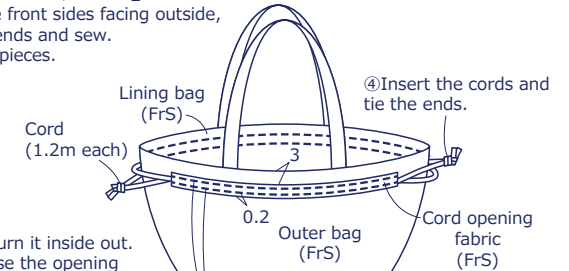
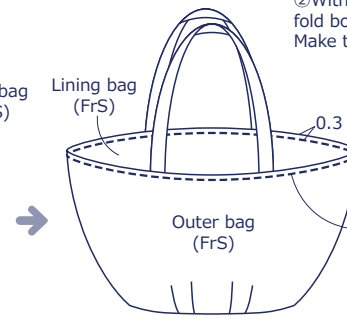


### 5. Make the cord opening fabric and finish

① With the front sides facing outside, fold the long ends of the cord opening fabric.



② With the front sides facing outside, fold both ends and sew. Make two pieces.



③ Attach the cord opening fabric.

② Turn it inside out. Close the opening and apply stitches around the top.

④ Insert the cords and tie the ends.
