## Materials

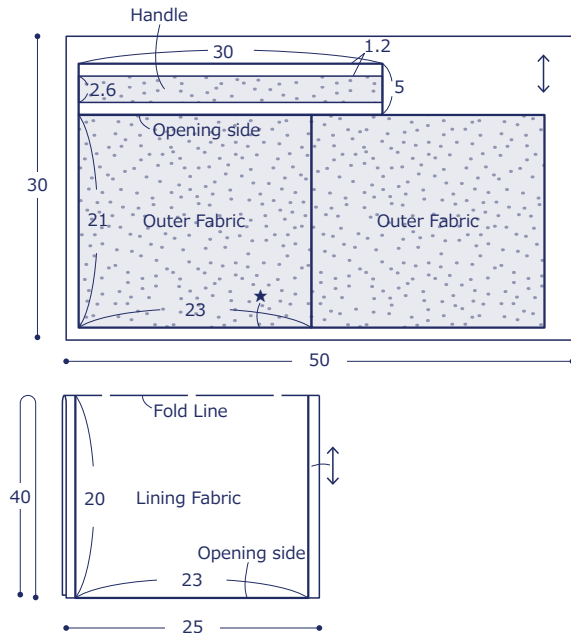
- Fabric (Outer Fabric, Handle): 50cm x 30cm
- Fabric (Lining Fabric): 25cm x 40cm
- Fusible Interfacing: 50cm x 30cm
- Zipper: 20cm x one piece
- Plasnap Snap Button: 1.3cm diameter x two pairs

Fabric shown for this sample: GRX-9107-1B

## Pattern and Cutting Layout

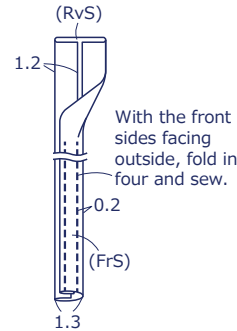
Unit: cm All raw edge

Adhere fusible interfacing to the back of the [ ] area.

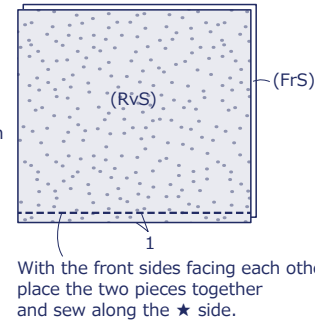


## Instructions Front Side - (FrS), Reverse Side (RvS)

### 1. Make the handle

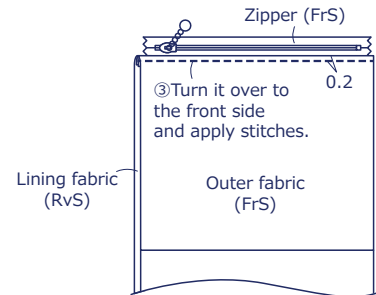
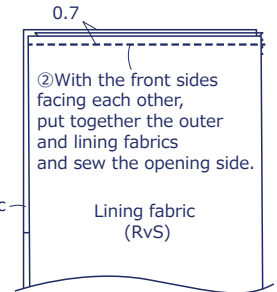
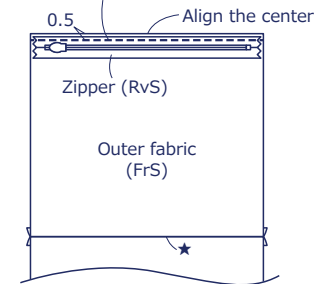


### 2. Make the outer fabric

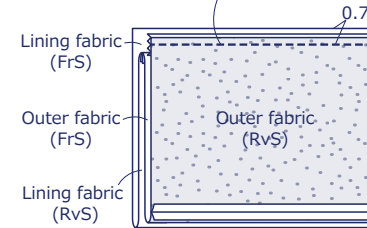


### 3. Finish the pouch

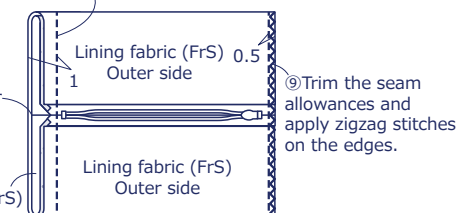
① With the front sides facing each other, put together the outer fabric and zipper and sew the opening side.



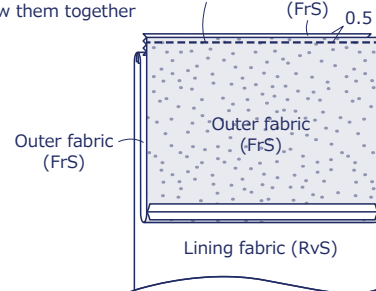
⑤ With the front sides facing each other, sew together the outer fabric and the opening on the opposite side of the lining fabric.



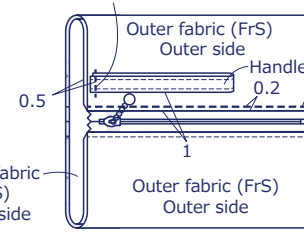
⑧ Turn the lining fabric inside out and sew both sides (leaving the zipper open).



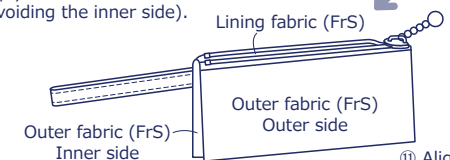
④ With front sides facing each other, align the zipper and the opening side of the outer fabric on the opposite side, then sew them together



⑦ Fold the handle in two and baste (avoiding the inner side).



⑥ Turn it inside out and apply stitches (avoiding the inner side).



⑩ Turn the outer fabric inside out and attach the Plasnap (avoiding the outer side).
