



Ruffled Drawstring Pouch

Size: 20cm (l) 22cm (w) 5cm (gusset)

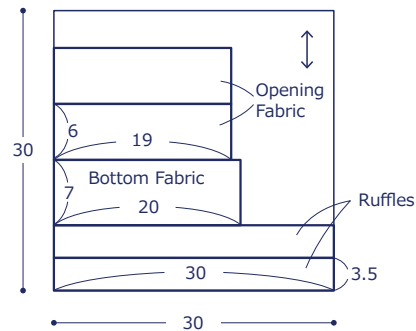
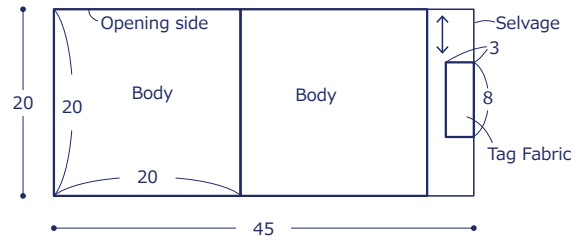
Materials

- Fabric (Body, Tag Fabric): 45cm x 20cm
- Fabric (Opening Fabric, Bottom Fabric, Ruffles): 30cm x 30cm
- Cord: 0.4cm diameter x 1m

Fabric shown for this sample: EGX-9240-4A

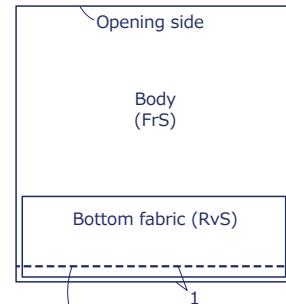
Pattern and Cutting Layout

Unit: cm. Cut all pieces to size, and apply zigzag stitches around the edges, excluding the tag fabric.



Instructions Front Side - (FrS), Reverse Side (RvS)

1. Make the body



① With the front sides facing each other, sew together the body and bottom fabric.

4. Make the tag fabric

① Stitch around the edges.

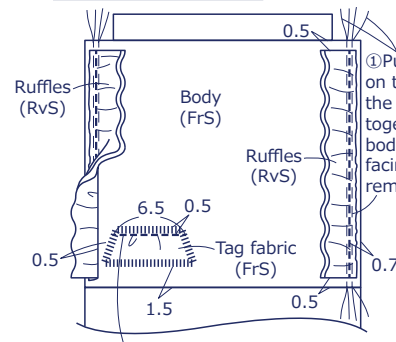


② Pull out the thread on the outer side of stitch ① to create fringe.



③ Apply rough stitches.

5. Finish the pouch



② Sew the tag fabric onto the main body and remove the basting stitches.

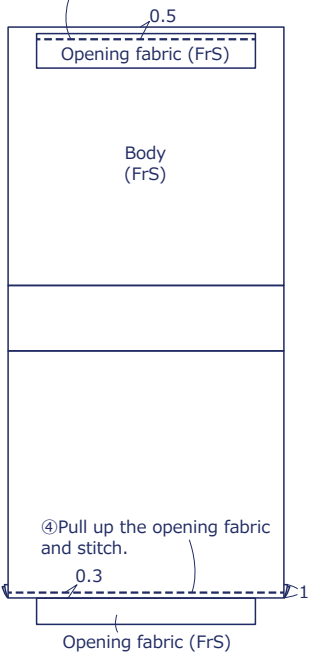
2. Make the opening fabric

① Fold both ends and sew.
② With the front sides facing outside, fold in half.
Attachment side
• Make two pieces.

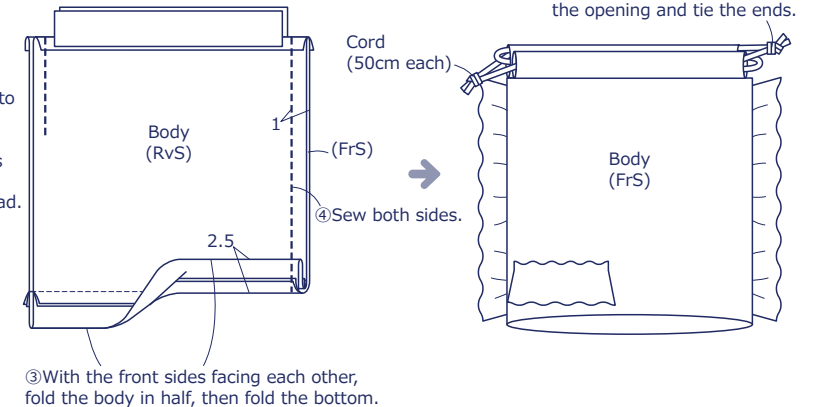
3. Make the ruffles

① Fold the short side and one of the long sides, then sew.
② Stitch the seam allowance with a loose basting stitch.
• Make two pieces.

③ Baste the opening fabric to the body.



⑤ Turn it inside out. Insert the cord through the opening and tie the ends.



③ With the front sides facing each other, fold the body in half, then fold the bottom.
