



Horizontally Long Tote Bag

Design & work: Kokka Fabric

Size: about 15cm (l)
about 37cm (w)
about 9cm (d)
(Handles excluded)

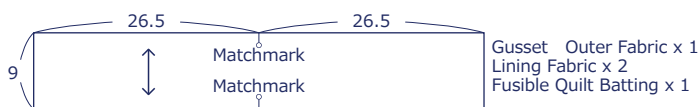
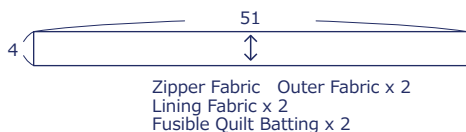
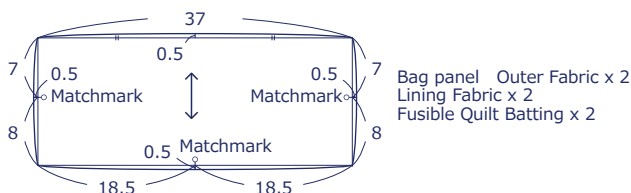
Materials

- Outer Fabric: about 110cm wide x 50cm
- Lining Fabric: about 110cm wide x 40cm
- Fusible Interfacing (Light Weight): about 90cm wide x 20cm
- Fusible Quilt Batting: about 90cm wide x 50cm
- Zipper: Once piece (50cm long)

Fabric shown for this sample: YGA-91050-1B

Pattern

Unit: cm. Add 1cm seam when cutting the fabric.



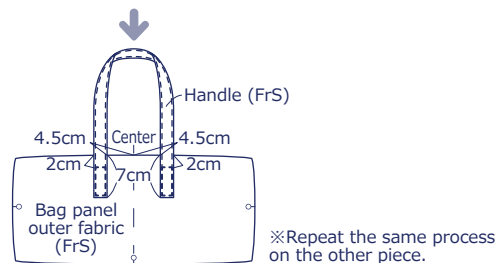
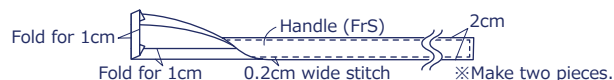
※Adhere fusible interfacing on the back of the handle.
Adhere fusible quilt batting on the back of the bag panel, outer zipper fabric and outer gusset.

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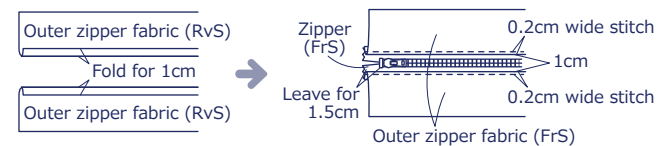
Instructions Front Side - (FrS), Reverse Side (RvS)

1. Make the handles



2. Attach the zipper to the outer zipper fabric

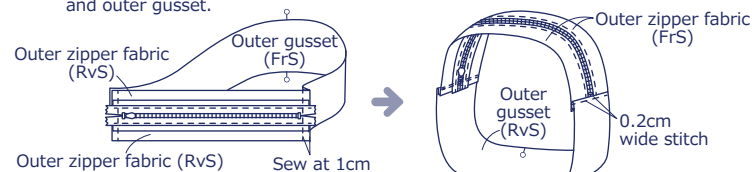
Fold the seam of the opening side of the outer zipper fabric. Layer it with the zipper and apply stitches.



3. Sew together the outer zipper fabric and outer gusset

With the front sides facing each other, sew together the outer zipper fabric and outer gusset.

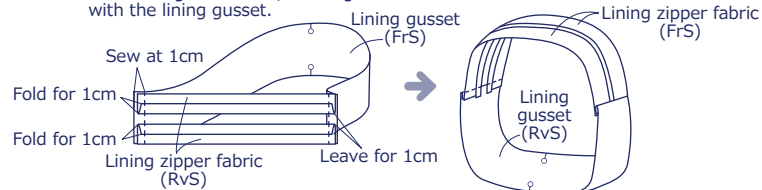
Press down the seam to the outer gusset side and apply stitches.



4. Sew together the lining zipper fabric and lining gusset

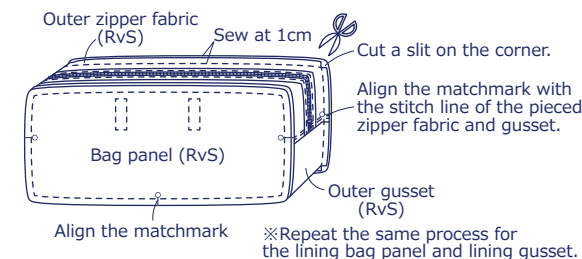
Fold the seam of the opening side of the lining zipper fabric. With the front sides facing each other, sew together with the lining gusset.

Press down the seam to the lining gusset side.



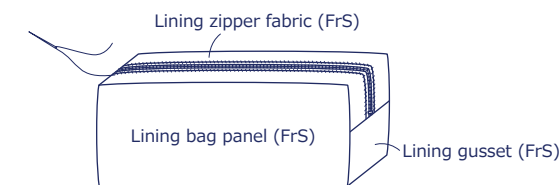
5. Sew together the bag panel and gusset

Open the zipper. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the bag panel and gusset.



6. Attach the lining panel to the zipper

With the front sides facing outside, sew together the outer bag panel and lining bag panel using blind stitches.



7. Turn it inside out and align the shape to finish
