Size: 20cm (w), 20cm (d), 10cm (h)

Materials and Tools

- Fabric (lining): 40cm×90cm
- Hemp cord (medium thickness jute cord for gardening/shipping) : One 100m roll
- A pair of Size 10 Knitting Needles

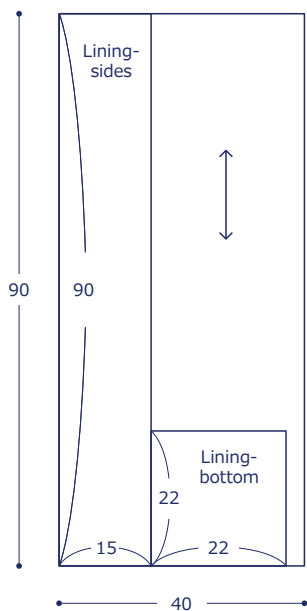
Gauge

- Moss Stitch 15 stitches, 25 rows, 10cm square

Fabric shown for this sample: echino bee JG95900-904 (c)

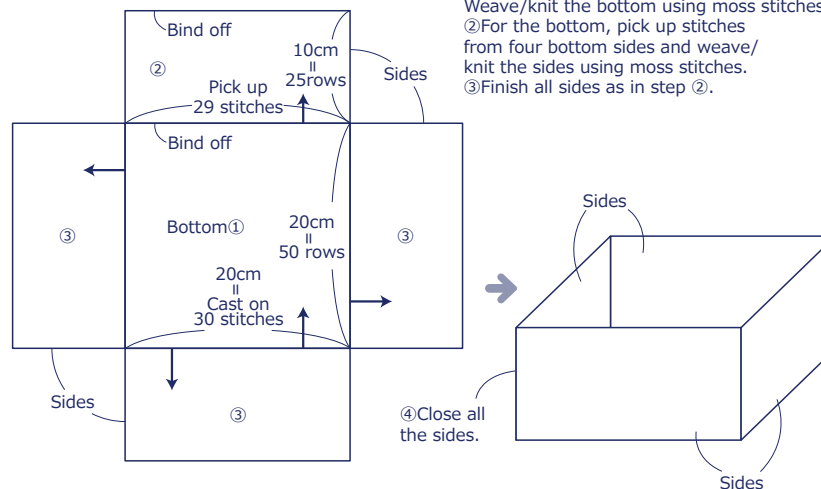
Cutting layout

All measurements are in centimeters (cm). Edges are left cut.



Instructions

1. Weave (knit) a basket.





Use a single cord.

- ① Start with the knit cast on.
Weave/knit the bottom using moss stitches.
- ② For the bottom, pick up stitches from four bottom sides and weave/knit the sides using moss stitches.
- ③ Finish all sides as in step ②.
