

Rose corsage in double gauze fabric

Design \& work created by titocetera
Size: about 7 cm (diameter of the rolled rose)

## Materials

$\square$ Fabric(Rose): $70 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$
(Leaf, Base fabric): $20 \mathrm{~cm} \times 20 \mathrm{~cm}$
$\square$ Interfacing: $10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$
$\square$ Suede Tape: 50 cm ( 0.5 cm width)
$\square$ Broach pin: One piece ( 3.5 cm length)
Fabric shown for this sample: (Rose) Joielinne P27000-700 (A) (Leaf, Base fabric) Joielinne P27010-10 (c )

## Cutting Layout

All measurements are in centimeters (cm). The edges are left cut.


## Instructions



3. Make a base fabric.
(2) Run small stitches
around the interfacing.
(Front/outer side)

(4) Attach a broach pin to the base fabric.
(4) Once you finish stitching to the end (4) Once you finish stitching to the end,
pull the thread and make the length to 35 cm .
