



Bags, small cases and drawstring bags made with ready-to-sew fabric

Size: Please refer to the cutting layout

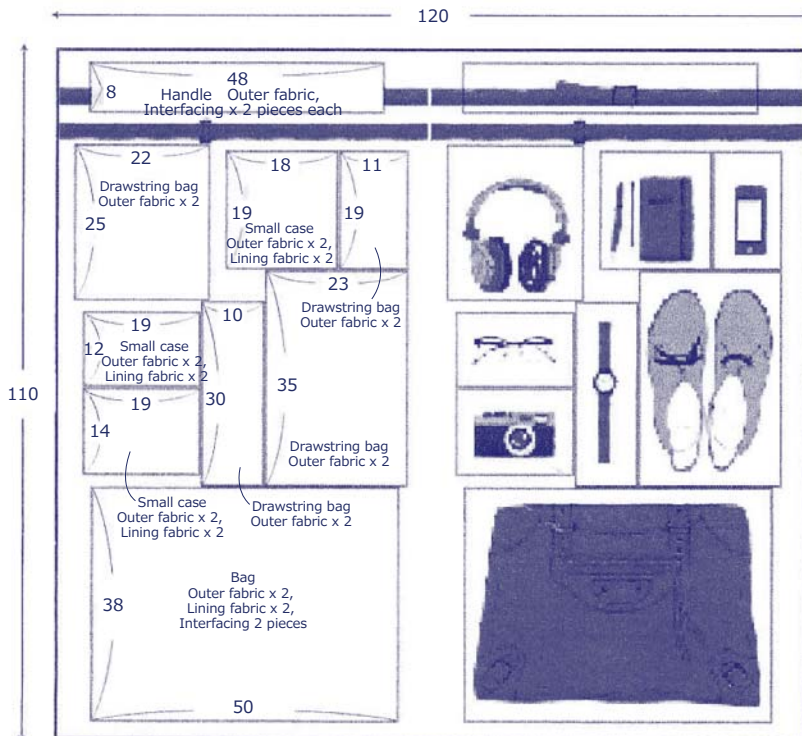
Materials

- Fabric (Outer fabric) over 110cm width x 120cm
(Lining fabric) over 110cm width x 80cm
- Interfacing: over 100cm width x 50cm
- Flat knit zipper: Three 20cm zippers
- Twilled tape: 2cm (width) x 15cm
- Acrylic tape: 7mm (width) x 160cm

Fabric shown for this sample: Making Cloth (ready-to-sew fabric) P28200-200 (A)

Cutting Layout

All measurements are in centimeters (cm). The edges are left cut.
(seam allowance included)

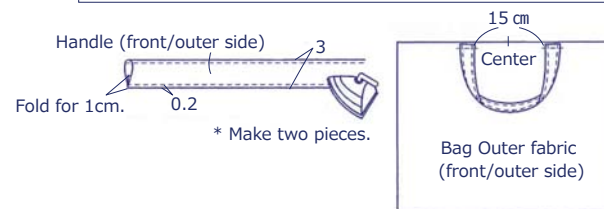


* Apply interfacing to the bag and handle fabrics

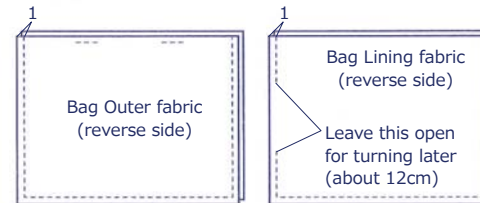
Instructions

Bag

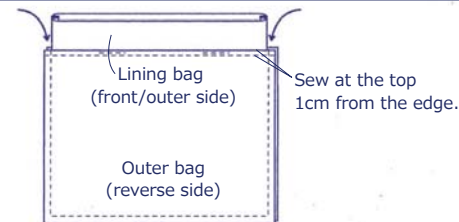
1. Make handles and baste them to the bag's outer fabric.



2. With outer sides facing each other, sew together the sides and bottom of the bag.



3. With outer sides facing each other, sew together the top side of the outer bag and lining bag.

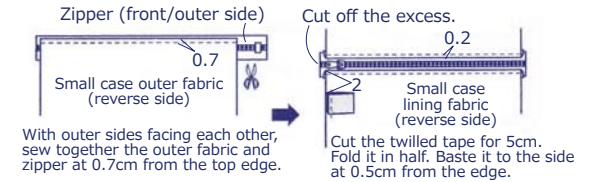


4. Turn it inside out and run a stitch at the top opening.



Small case

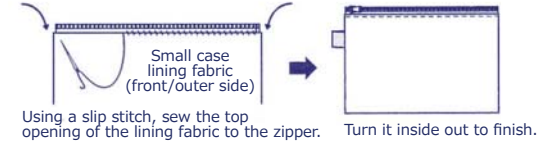
1. Attach a zipper to the outer fabric of the small case.



2. With outer sides facing each other, sew together the sides and bottom of the case.

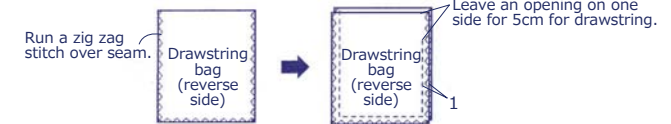


3. Using a slip stitch, sew the top opening of the lining fabric to the zipper to finish.

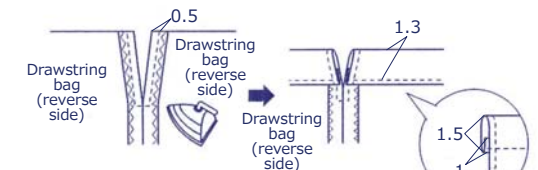


Drawstring bag

1. With outer sides facing each other, sew together the sides and bottom of the bag



2. Double fold the top of the bag and run stitches.



3. Put the drawstring through to finish.
