

# Zipper Pouch with Gathering

Size: 13cm (l) 20cm (w) 4cm(d)

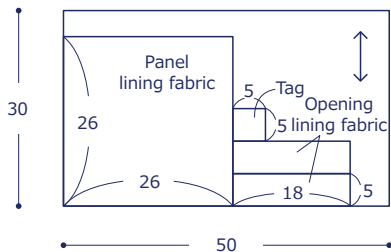
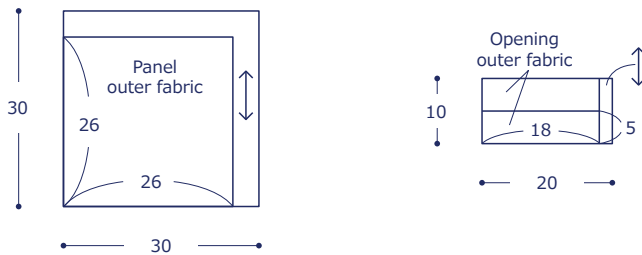
## Materials

- Fabric (Panel outer fabric): 30cm×30cm  
(Opening outer fabric): 20cm×10cm  
(Tag, Lining fabric): 50cm×30cm
- Zipper: One piece (30cm)

Fabric shown for this sample: ellen baker Monochrome JG42300-300 (B)

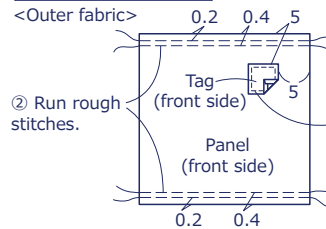
## Pattern and Cutting Layout

All measurements are in centimeters (cm). The edges are left cut.



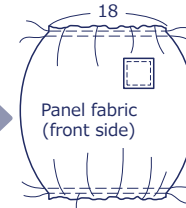
## Instructions

### 1. Make the panels.



② Run rough stitches.

① Fold the edge of the tag for 0.5cm all the way around. Sew the tag to the panel outer fabric.

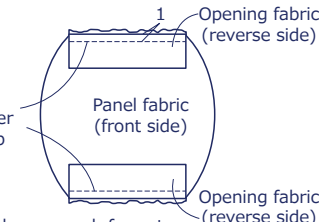


③ Pull the thread from ②.

### 2. Sew together the panel and opening fabrics.

<Lining fabric>  
Repeat the same outer fabric process ② and ③ for lining fabric.

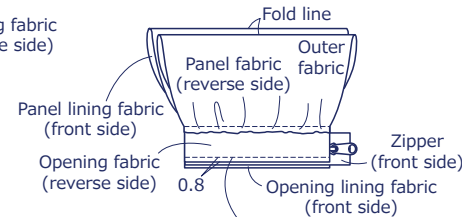
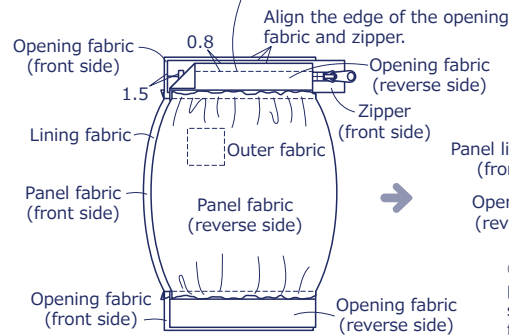
With front sides facing each other, sew together the panel fabric and top opening fabric.



\*Make one each for outer fabric and lining fabric.

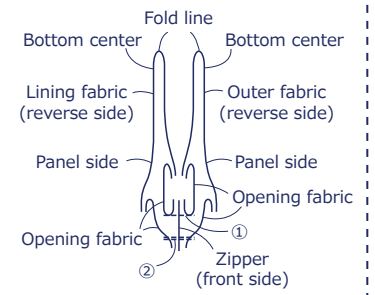
### 3. Attach the zipper.

① With front sides facing each other, sew together the outer and lining fabrics with the zipper in-between.



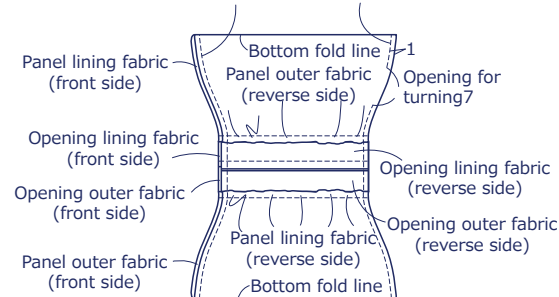
② With front sides facing each other, place the outer and lining fabrics, sew together the other opening fabric and zipper as in process ①.

### Cross section

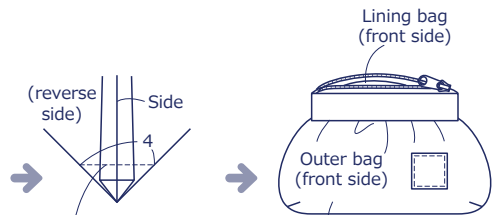
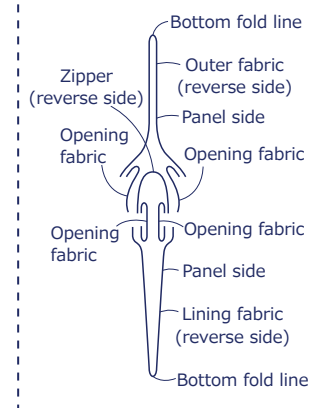


### 4. Make the bags.

① Open the zipper. Fold outer fabric and lining fabric in half with front sides facing each other, and sew the sides. (Leave an opening for turning on one side.)



### Cross section



② Fold the bottom corner into triangle to make a gusset.

\*Make four gussets.

③ Turn it inside out, close the opening and align the shape.
