

Runlala Rabbit Tote Bag

Design & work: Kokka Fabric

Size: about 30cm (I) x about 50cm (w) about 20cm (w)
*not including handles


Materials

- $\hfill \square$ Outer fabric Pattern A 40cm x 110cm or wider
- □ Outer fabric Pattern B 10cm x 110cm or wider
- □ Lining fabric 50cm x 110cm or wider
- ☐ Fusible quilt batting 60cm x 90cm or wider
- □ Tape for handles 100cm x 4.5cm wide

Fabric shown for this sample: P37900-900 (A)

Pattern and Cutting Layout


All measurements are in centimeters (cm). Add 1cm seam when cutting the fabric.





Instructions

1. With front sides facing each other, sew together the outer bag fabric and transition fabric.



5. Sew the gussets.



* Repeat the process for another piece of fabric.

2. Adhere fusible quilt batting on the reverse side of the outer bag fabric.




3. Baste handles to the outer fabric.

8cm 8cm 0.5cm from the edge.

Cut the handle tape in half - 50cm x 2

* Repeat the handle basting process for the other piece of fabric.

6. With front sides facing each other, sew together the outer bag and lining bag at the top opening.



7. Turn it inside out and close the opening for turning. Run top stitches at the opening to finish!
