



Relaxed Look Shoulder Bag

Size: 30cm (l) 45cm (w) at the top opening 10cm (d)

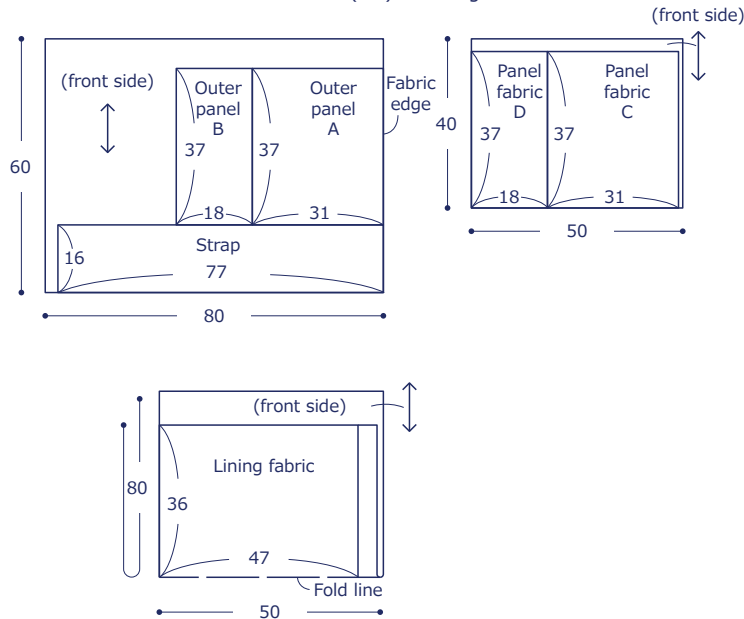
Materials

- Fabric (Panel A, B Strap): 80cm×60cm
(Panel C, D): 50cm×40cm
(Lining fabric): 50cm×80cm
- Magnetic clasp (hook type): 1 pair (1.8cm diameter)
- Patch fabric or interfacing: 10cm×10cm

Fabric shown for this sample: echino damask JG96150-51 (A), (C)

Pattern and Cutting Layout

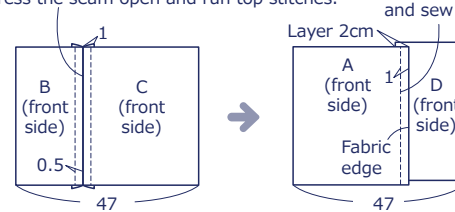
All measurements are in centimeters (cm). The edges are left cut.



Instructions

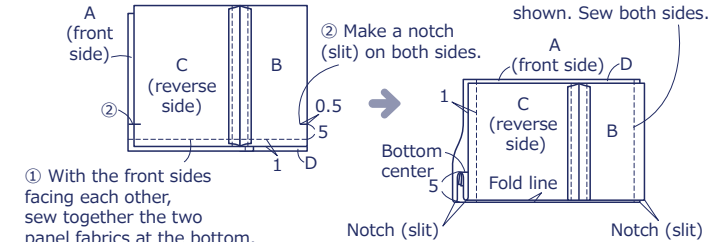
1. Prepare the outer panel fabrics.

- ① With the front sides facing each other, sew together the panels B and C. Press the seam open and run top stitches.
- ② Layer panels A and D as shown and sew together. Press the seam open and run top stitches.



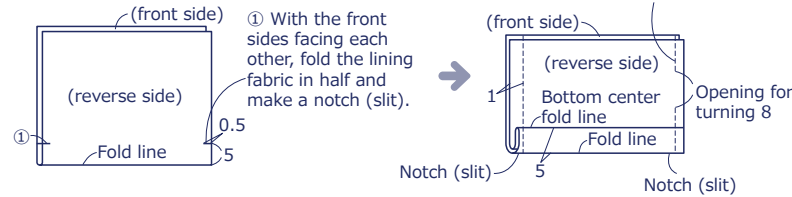
2. Make the outer bag.

- ① With the front sides facing each other, sew together the two panel fabrics at the bottom.
- ② Make a notch (slit) on both sides.
- ③ Align the notch and fold the bottom as shown. Sew both sides.



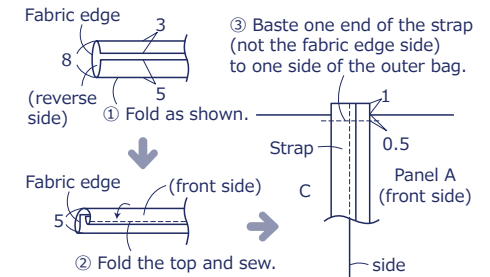
3. Make the lining bag.

- ① With the front sides facing each other, fold the lining fabric in half and make a notch (slit).
- ② Fold the bottom as shown. Leave an opening for turning on one side and sew both sides.



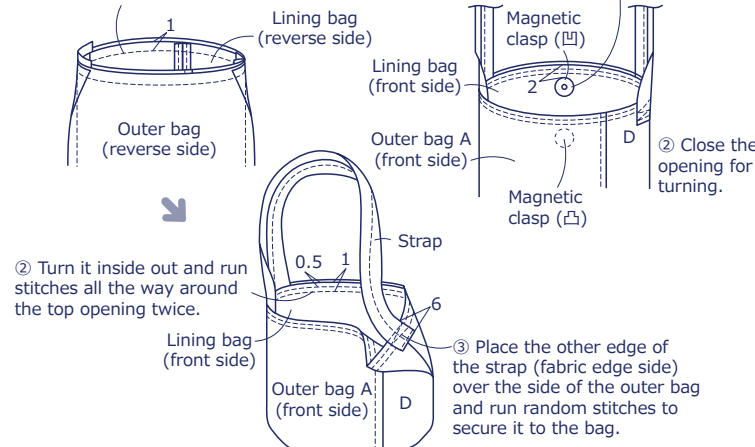
4. Make the strap.

- ① Fold as shown.
- ② Fold the top and sew.
- ③ Baste one end of the strap (not the fabric edge side) to one side of the outer bag.



5. Make the bag.

- ① With the front sides facing each other, place the outer bag into the lining bag. Sew together around the top.
- ② Turn it inside out and run stitches all the way around the top opening twice.



6. Attach the magnetic clasp.

- ① Attach the magnetic clasp to the lining bag.
- ② Close the opening for turning.
- ③ Place the other edge of the strap (fabric edge side) over the side of the outer bag and run random stitches to secure it to the bag.

How to attach the magnetic clasp

- ① Place the patch fabric or adhere interfacing where the button is attached. Align the center hole to the center mark.
- ② Mark the center.
- ③ Using the flat piece, mark the hook locations.
- ④ Cut a slit.
- ⑤ Piece the hooks through the flat piece and fabric.
- ⑥ Press down the hooks to secure.
