



Quilt Lesson Bag

Design & work: Kokka Fabric

Size: 32cm (l) 43cm (w) (excluding handles)

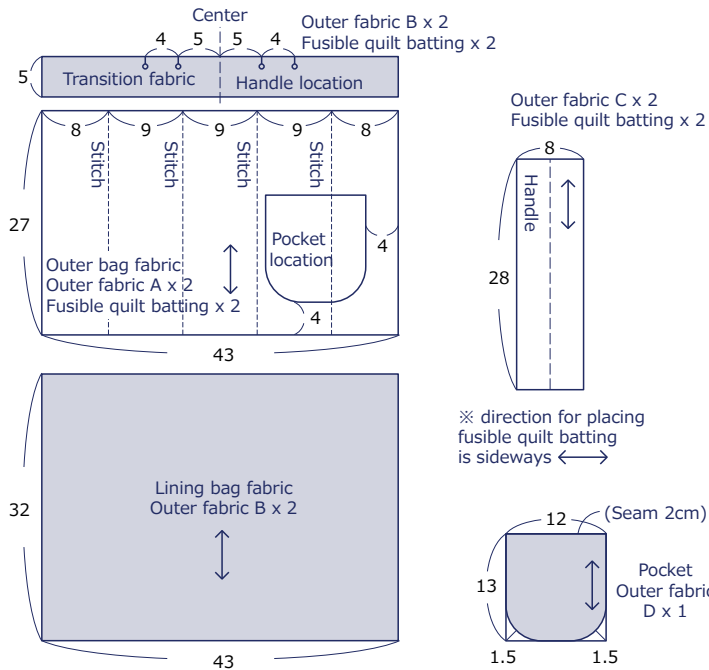
Materials

Outer Fabric A (Outer bag fabric) 40cm x 110cm wide or over
 Outer Fabric B (Transition fabric) 50cm x 110cm wide or over
 Outer Fabric C (Handle) 35cm x 110cm wide or over
 Outer Fabric D (Pocket) 20cm x 110cm wide or over

Fusible Quilt Batting 60cm x 95cm wide or over
 Fabric shown for this sample: (Outer Fabric B,C,D)P38500-502 (C)
 (Outer Fabric A) P38500-501 (C)

Pattern

All measurements are in centimeters (cm). Numbers in () denote seam allowance. All seam allowances 1cm unless otherwise stated.



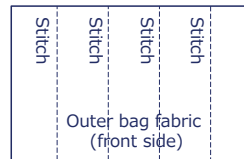
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Instructions

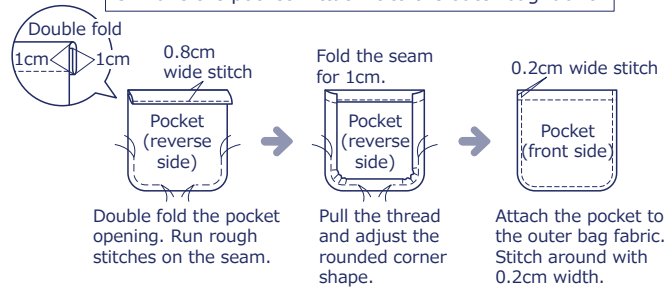
1. Adhere fusible quilt batting.

Adhere quilt batting to the back of the outer bag fabric, transition fabric and handle.

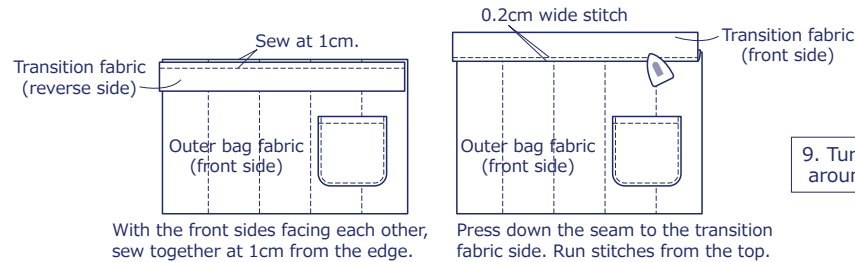
2. Run stitches on the outer bag fabric.



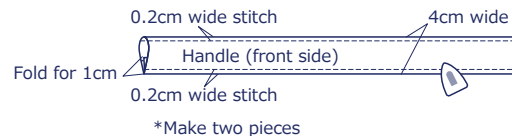
3. Make the pocket. Attach it to the outer bag fabric.



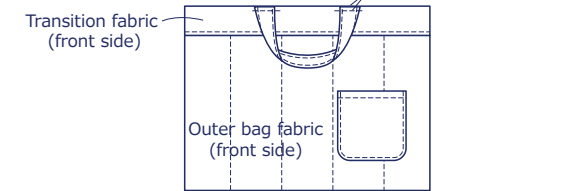
4. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the outer bag fabric and transition fabric.



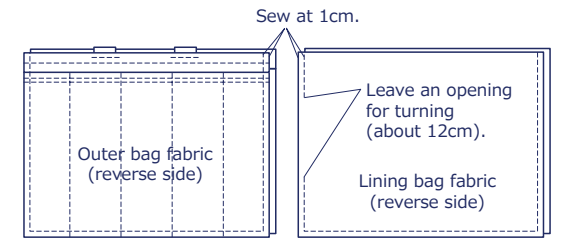
5. Fold the handle to the finished size. Run stitches on both long ends.



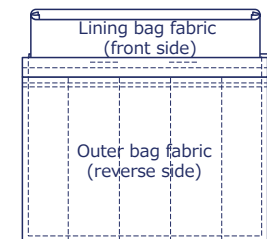
6. Baste the handles.



7. With the front sides facing each other, put together the bag fabrics and sew at the sides and bottom.



7. With the front sides facing each other, put together the bag fabrics and sew around the top opening.



9. Turn the bag inside out. Run top stitches around the top opening to finish.
