



# Shoulder Bag

Design & work: Yuki Inomata

Size: 30cm (l) 35cm (w) 8cm (d)

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## Materials

- Fabric (Panel outer fabric, Shoulder strap a, c): 106cm wide x 70cm (Bottom outer fabric, Main bag lining fabric, Shoulder strap b, Tab, Loop): 80x70cm

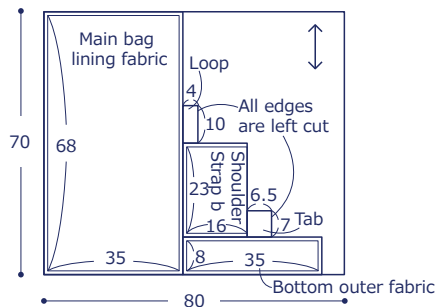
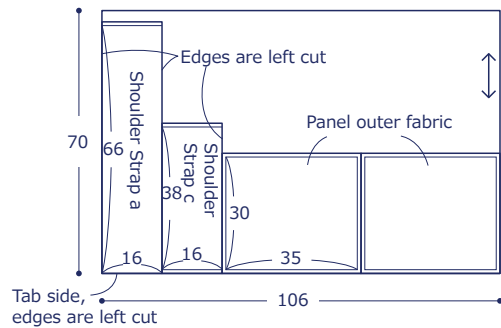
(Panel outer fabric, Shoulder strap a,c) naniIRO Lei nani JG10311 (D) water silhouette (Water Silhouette)

## Pattern

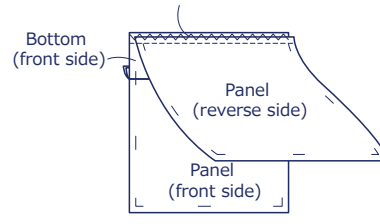
All measurements are in centimeters (cm).  
Add 1cm seam allowance unless specified otherwise.



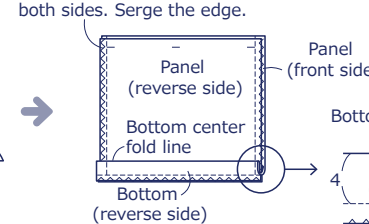
## Instructions

### 1. Make the outer bag.

① With the front sides facing each other, sew together the panel and bottom fabric. Serge the side.

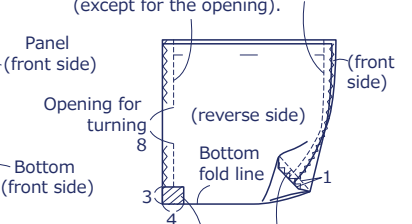


② With the front sides facing each other, fold in half. Then fold the bottom and sew both sides. Serge the edge.



### 2. Make the lining bag.

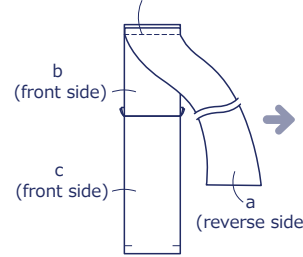
② Sew both sides (leaving an opening on one side), and serge the seam (except for the opening).



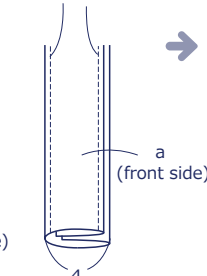
① With the front sides facing each other, fold the main bag lining fabric in half and cut off the bottom corners. ③ Sew the gusset. Serge the seam.

### 3. Make the shoulder strap.

① With the front sides facing each other, sew together the pieces a, b and c. Press down the seam to fabric b.



② With the front sides facing outside, fold in four and sew.

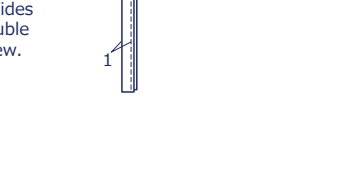


③ Layer the tab and sew.



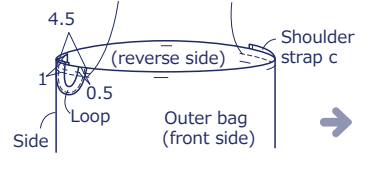
### 4. Make the loop.

⑤ With the front sides facing outside, double fold the tab and sew.

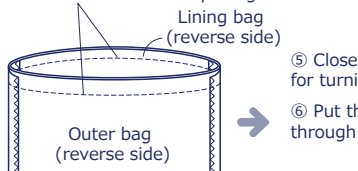


### 5. Sew together the outer bag and lining bag.

① Turn the outer bag inside out. Baste the shoulder strap and loop.



② With the front sides facing each other, put together the outer and lining bags and sew around the opening.



⑤ Close the opening for turning.

⑥ Put the shoulder strap through the loop and tie.
