Materials

☐ Fabric (Outer fabric): 110cm wide×50cm (Lining fabric a (canvas)): 90cm×50cm

(Lining fabric b (canvas)): 30cm×50cm ☐ Fusible interfacing: 80cm×10cm

□ Rope: 1.4m (0.8cm diameter)


☐ Grommet: 8 pairs (1.0cm inside diameter)


☐ Button: 2 pairs (1.5cm diameter)

Pattern and Cutting Layout


All measurements are in centimeters (cm). Add 1cm seam when cutting the fabric.






1. Make the outer bag.

①Adhere fusible interfacing to the outer fabric.



3Fold the bottom and sew the pocket. (you may align the pocket along the fabric's pattern)



6 Cut off the excess and serge the seam. *Make another gusset

Bottom center on the other side.



other, fold in half and sew both ends.

2. Make the lining bag.

1) With the front sides facing each other, sew together a and b. Press the seam open.



3. Sew together the outer bag and lining bag.

①Fold the opening of both outer bag and

lining bag. With the front sides facing outside, tie the end. (To prevent it from fraying, sew together the bags. apply glue or anti-fray at the knot) (Avoid overlapping the pocket side) Lining bag (front/pocket side) Outer bag (front side) ②Using a hole punch, Outer make holes and attach bag the arommet.
