58cm (w - maximum)

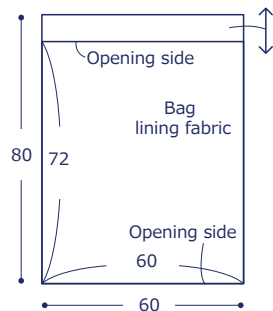
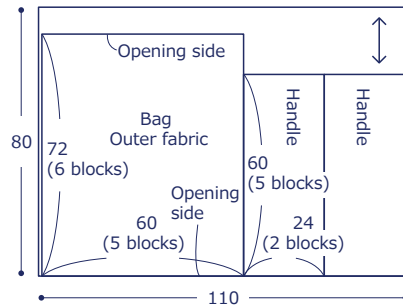
Materials

- Fabric (Bag outer fabric, handle): 110cm wide x 80cm
(Bag lining fabric): 60cm x 80cm

Fabric shown for this sample: echino JG96500-500 (c)

Pattern

All measurements are in centimeters (cm). All edges are left cut.



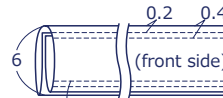
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Instructions

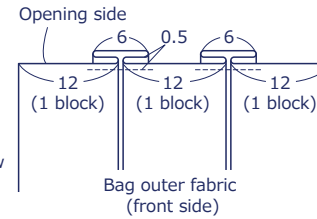
1. Make the handle.



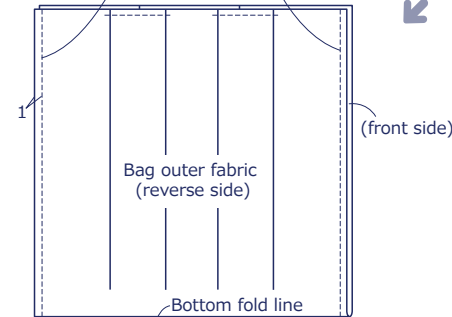
With the outer sides facing outside, fold in four and sew the long sides.
• Make two pieces.

2. Make the outer bag.

- ① Make the tucks on the edges of the opening side and baste them.
• Repeat the process on the other side.

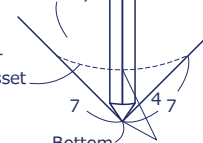


- ② With the front sides facing each other, fold in half and sew both sides.

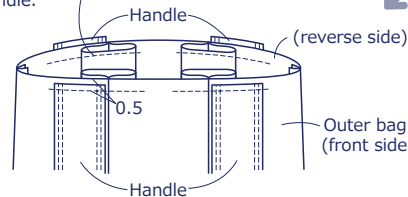


Bag outer fabric (reverse side) Side

- ③ Fold the bottom corner in a triangle. Sew the gusset with a curved stitch line.
• Repeat the process on the other side.



- ④ Turn it inside out and baste the handle.

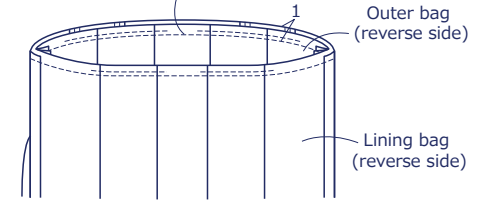


3. Make the lining bag.

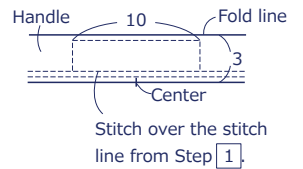
Prepare the bag lining fabric. Use the same process as in Step 2 ①~③. (Leave an opening for turning on one side for 8cm.)

4. Finish the bag.

- ① With the frons sides facing each other, sew together the outer bag and lining bag at the opening.

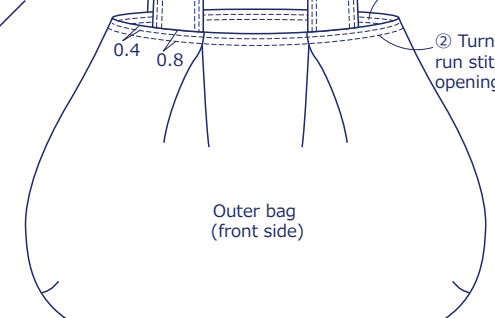


- ③ Fold the center of the handle in half and sew in a rectangle shape.



Handle Lining bag (front side)

- ② Turn it inside out and run stitches along the opening.



- ④ Close the opening for turning.
