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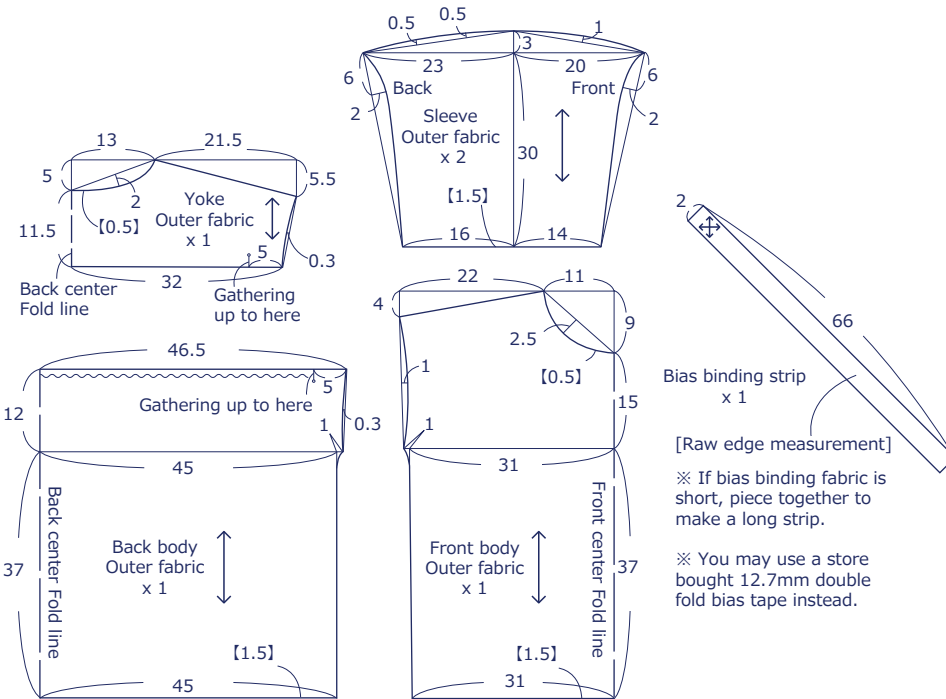
Materials

□ Fabric: 110cm wide x 180cm

Fabric shown for this sample: 45400-400C

Pattern

Unit: cm []: Seam allowance.
Add 1cm seam allowance unless specified otherwise.

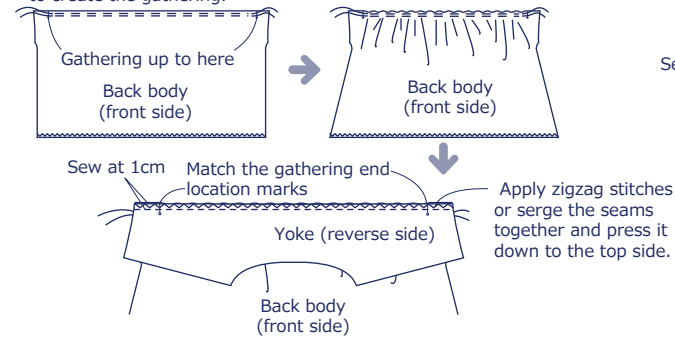


Instructions

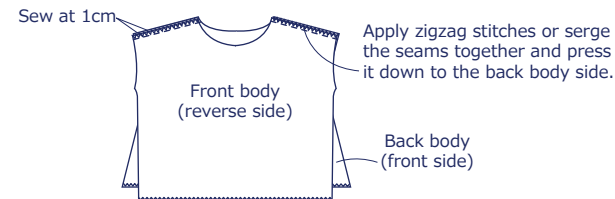
1. Apply zigzag stitches or serge the seams of the front and back body hems.

2. Apply gathering on the back body. With the front sides facing each other, sew together with the yoke.

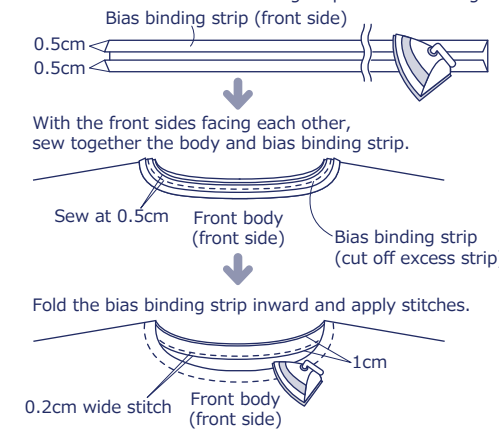
Run rough stitches up to the end of the gathering. Pull the thread to create the gathering.



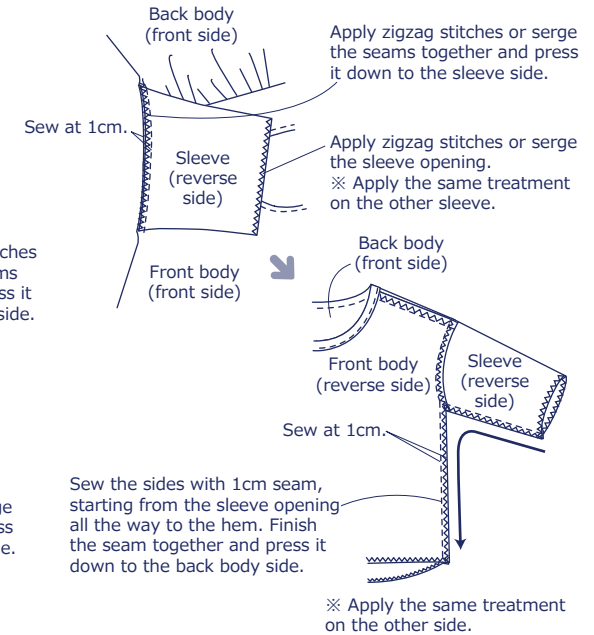
3. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the front body and back body at the shoulder.



Fold both ends of the bias binding strip for 0.5cm using an iron.



5. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the sleeves and body.



6. Double fold the sleeve opening and hem and sew to finish.
