



# Tissue Box Case

Size: 15cm (h) 30cm (w - opening)  
24cm (bottom) 13cm (d)

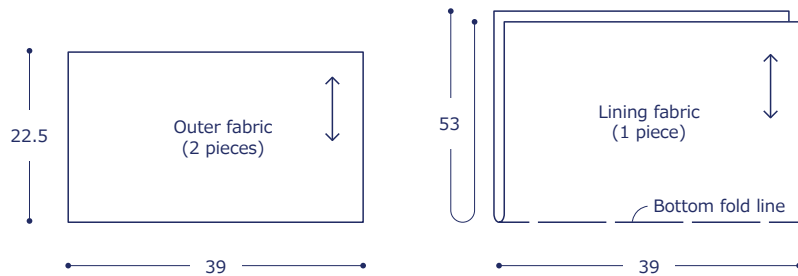
## Materials

- Fabric (Outer fabric): 110cm wide×30cm  
(Lining fabric): 40cm×60cm
- Snap: Two pairs (1cm diameter)

Fabric shown for this sample: (Outer fabric) Real Printe P46000-601A Canvas

## Pattern and Cutting Layout

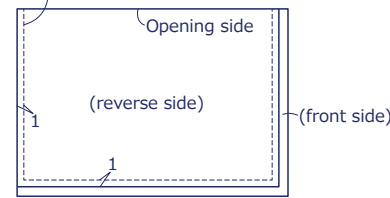
All measurements are in centimeters (cm). All raw edges.



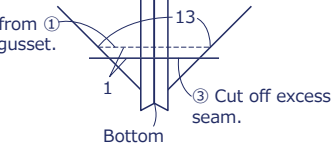
## Instructions

### 1. Make the outer bag.

① With the front sides facing each other, sew together the outer fabrics at the sides and bottom, leaving top opening unsewn.



② Press the seam from ① open and sew the gusset.



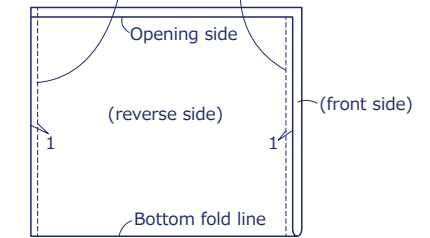
③ Cut off excess seam.

④ Turn it inside out.

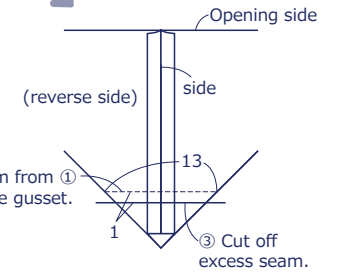
• Repeat the same process on the other side.

### 2. Make the lining bag.

① With the front sides facing each other, fold the lining bag in half and sew the sides.



② Press the seam from ① open and sew the gusset.

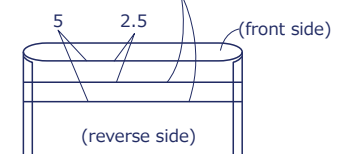


③ Cut off excess seam.

• Repeat the same process on the other side.

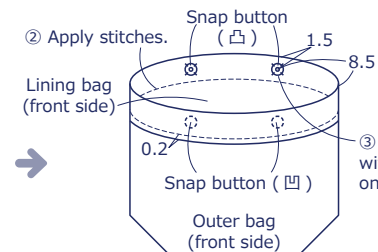
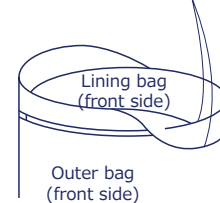


④ Fold the edge of the top opening in three and iron to score.



### 3. Finish the case.

① With the front sides facing outside, layer the outer bag and lining bag. Fold the edge of the top opening of the lining bag in three and wrap around the top opening of the outer bag.



② Apply stitches.

③ Attach the snap button without revealing stitches on the outer side.
