



# Front Tuck Dress

Design & work: Kokka Fabric

Size: M

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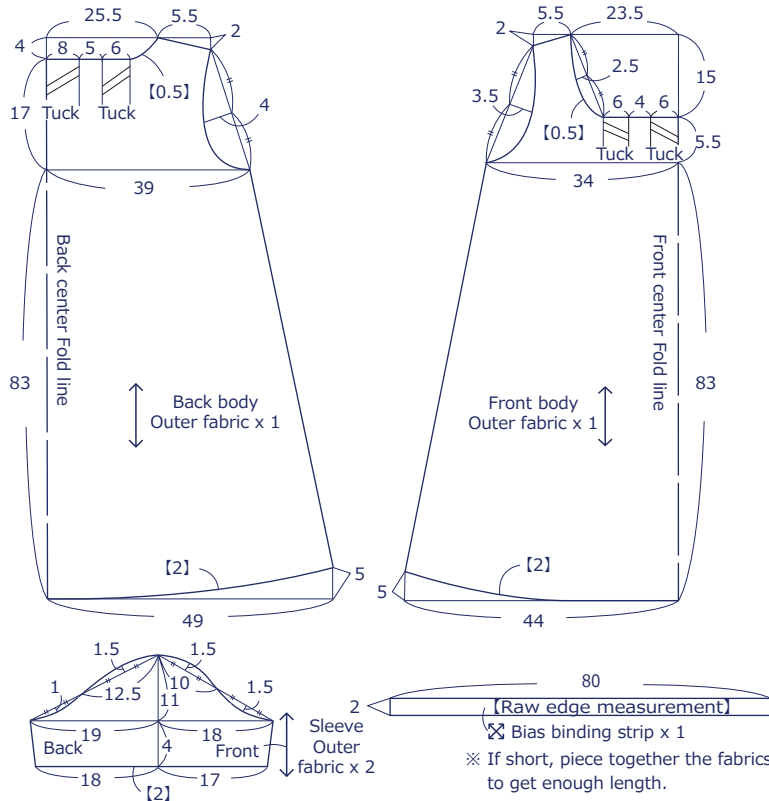
## Materials

□ Outer fabric: 110cm wide x 270cm

Fabric shown for this sample: echino habitat JG96700-702B Cotton Linen Canvas

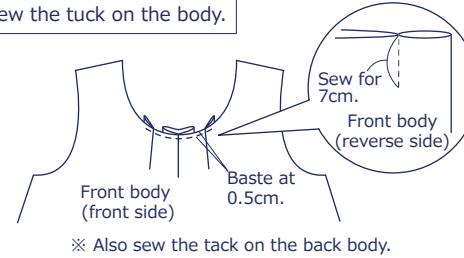
## Pattern

Unit: Centimeters (cm) [ ]: Seam allowance  
Add 1cm seam allowance when you cut the fabric unless otherwise stated.

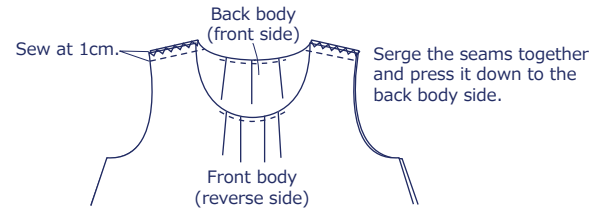


## Instructions

1. Sew the tuck on the body.

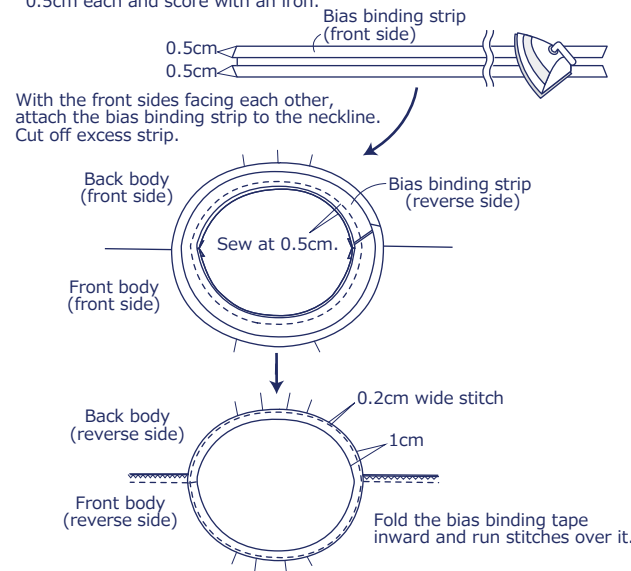


2. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the front and back bodies at the shoulder.

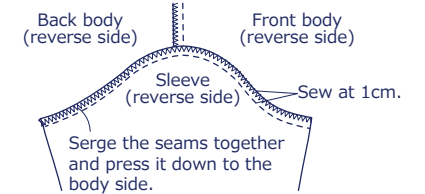


3. Finish the neckline with a bias binding strip.

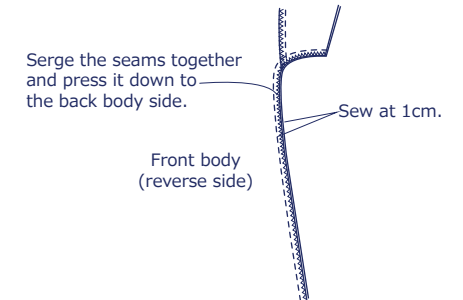
Fold top and bottom ends of the bias binding strip for 0.5cm each and score with an iron.



4. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the body and sleeve.



5. Sew the sides of the body.



6. Double fold the armhole and hem. Run stitches.
