Design & work: Kokka Fabric
Size: about 30cm (I)
about 36cm (w)
about 23cm (exclude handles)

 $\ \square$  Fusible interfacing (heavy weight): 110cm wide x 70cm


☐ Flat tape: 4.5cm widex70cm

### Pattern & Cutting Layout

Unit: cm. [ ]:denote seam allowance.

Add 1cm seam allowance unless otherwise specified.



Adhere fusible interfacing on the back of the outer bag fabric and outer bottom fabric.

#### Instructions


#### 1. Make the pocket and attach it to the outer bag fabric

Fold the pocket opening in three and run stitches. Fold for 1cm all the way around.




2. Piece together the outer bag fabrics


With the front sides facing each other, piece together eight outer bag fabrics.




3. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the bag fabric and bottom fabric



4. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the outer and lining bag fabrics at the top opening



5. Turn it inside out and run stitches around the top opening



6. Make the handles and attach them to the bag fabric

Cut the handle tape to 35cm each. (two pieces) Fold the center of the handle in half and run stitches.
