



# Front Tuck Dress

Design & work: Kokka Fabric

Size: M

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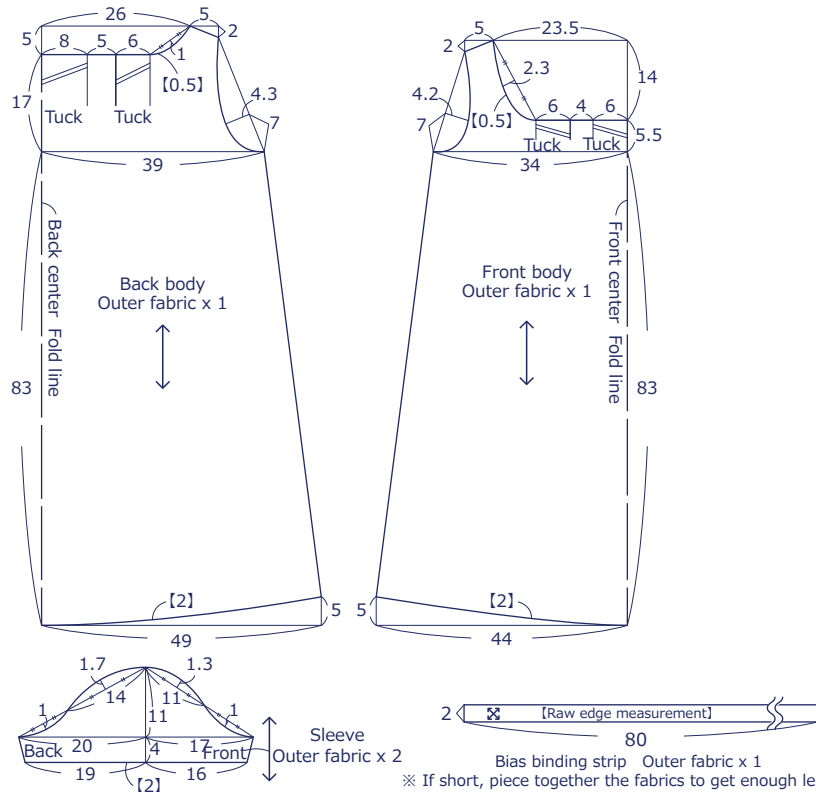
## Materials

□ Outer fabric: 110cm wide x 270cm

Fabric shown for this sample: Botanical YK-71090-1C

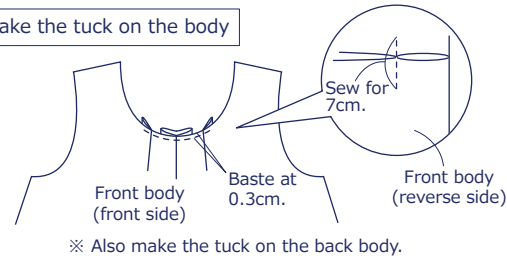
## Pattern

Unit: Centimeters (cm) [ ]: Seam allowance  
Add 1cm seam allowance when you cut the fabric unless otherwise stated.

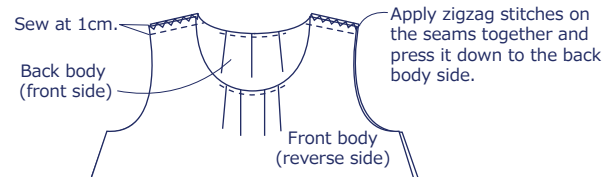


## Instructions

1. Make the tuck on the body

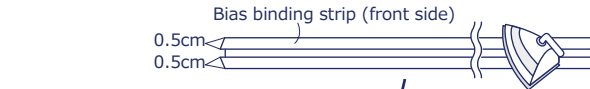


2. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the front and back bodies at the shoulder

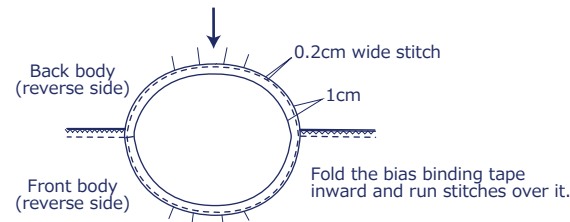
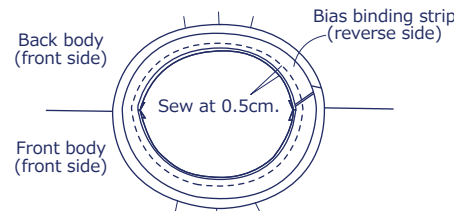


3. Finish the neckline with a bias binding strip

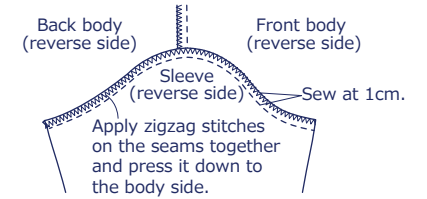
Fold top and bottom ends of the bias binding strip for 0.5cm respectively and score with an iron.



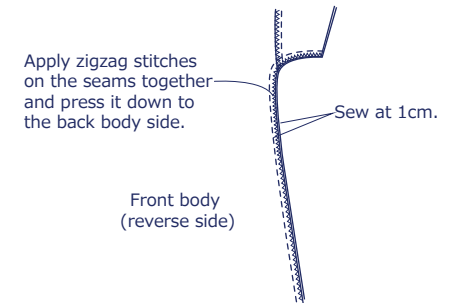
With the front sides facing each other, attach the bias binding strip to the neckline. Cut off excess strip.



4. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the body and sleeves.



5. Sew the sides of the body



6. Fold the armhole and hem in three. Run stitches
