Face Mask: 9.8cm (l) 18cm (w)

Mask Case: 21cm (l) 11.5cm (w)

Tissue Case : 14cm (l) 11.5cm (w)

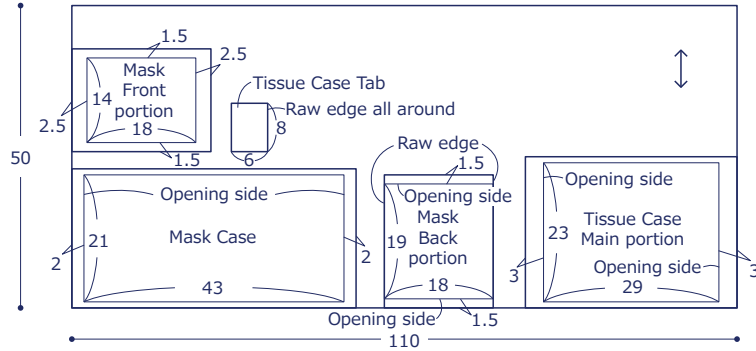
## Materials

- Fabric: 110cm wide x 50cm
- Elastic: 60cm (0.3cm wide)
- Wire: 10cm (0.5cm wide)
- Snap: Three pairs (0.8cm diameter)

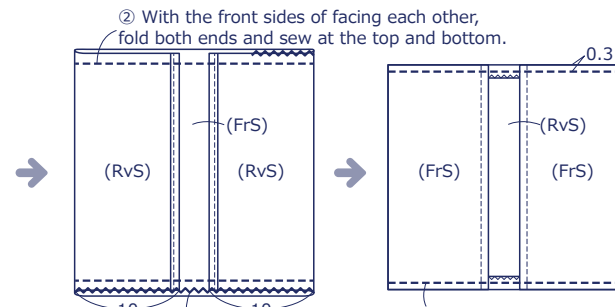
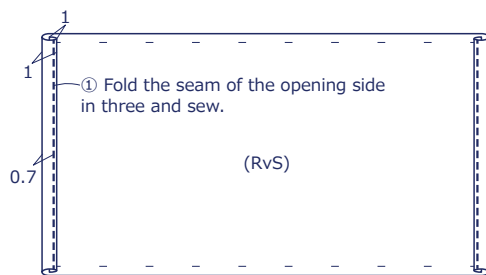
Fabric shown for this sample: Indigo YK-71030-1C

## Pattern and Cutting Layout

Unit: cm Add 1cm seam unless otherwise specified.



### <Mask Case>



③ Apply zigzag stitches on the top and bottom.

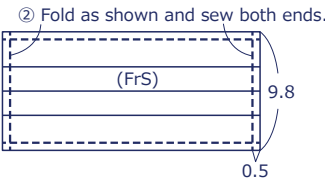
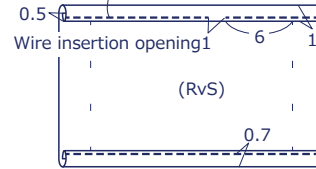
④ Turn it inside out and apply stitches at the top and bottom.

## Instructions Front Side (FrS), Reverse Side (RvS)

### <Face Mask>

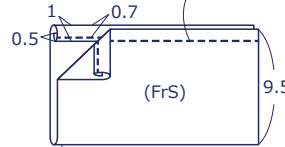
#### 1. Make the front portion

① Fold the seam at the top and bottom in three and sew. (Leave an opening for wire at the top.)

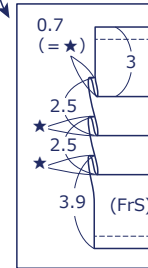


#### 2. Make the back portion

① Fold the seam of the opening side in three and sew.

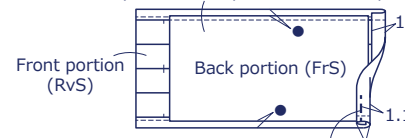


② With the front sides facing outside, fold in half.

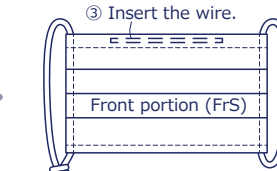


#### 3. Finish the piece

① With the front sides facing outside, layer the front portion and back portion.



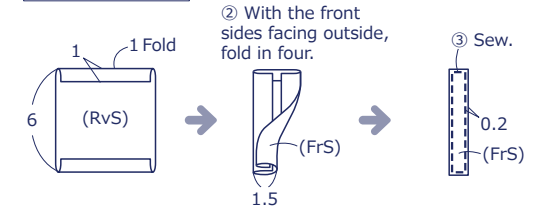
② Fold the seam of the side ends of the front portion in three and sew.



④ Insert the elastic (30cm each) and tie the ends.

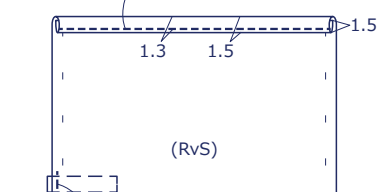
### <Tissue Case>

#### 1. Make the tab



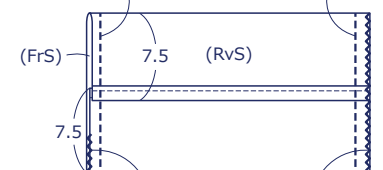
#### 2. Make the main portion and finish

① Fold the seam of the opening side in three and sew.



② Layer the tab in the center of the surface and baste.

③ With the front sides facing each other, fold in three and sew both ends.



④ Apply zigzag stitches on both ends.

⑤ Turn it inside out and attach snaps.
