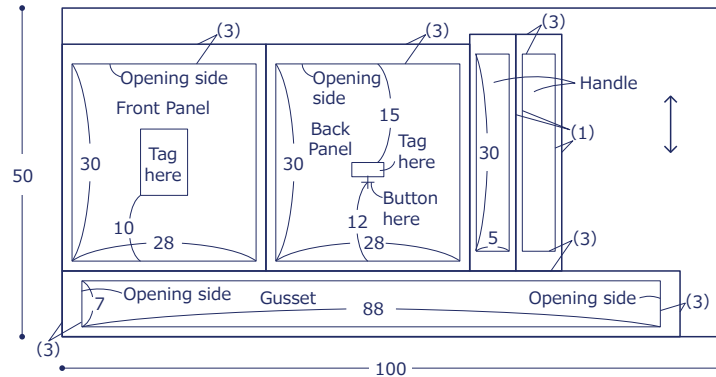
Materials

- Fabric: 100cm x 50cm
- Elastic: 20cm (0.1cm diameter)
- Button: One piece (1.9cm diameter)
- Tag - Large: One piece
- Tag - Small: One piece

Fabric shown for this sample: YKA-560-1B

Pattern and Cutting Layout

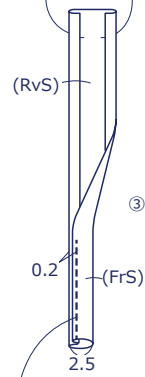
Unit: Centimeters (cm) Numbers in () denote seam allowance.
1.5cm seam allowance unless otherwise specified.



Instructions Front Side - (FrS), Reverse Side (RvS)

1. Make the handles

- ① Fold the seam of the long end.



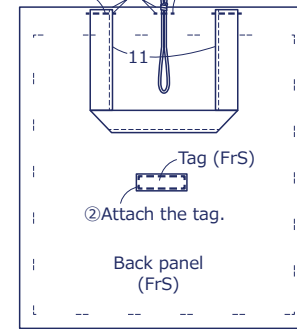
- ② With the front sides facing outside, fold in half and sew. • Make two pieces.

2. Attach each parts on the panel

- ① Tie the ends of the elastic.

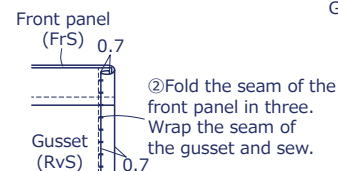
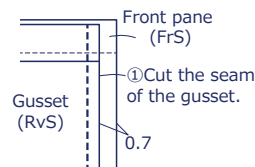


- ③ Baste the handle.
- ④ Baste the elastic.



4. Finish the bag

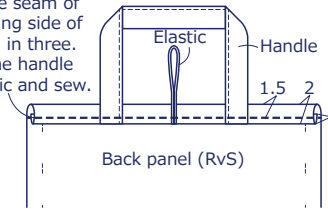
- Repeat the process ② and ③ on the front panel.



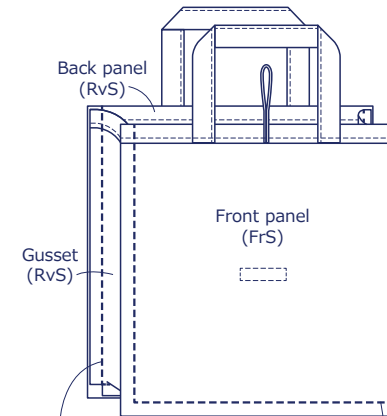
- Repeat the same process on the back panel.

3. Piece together the panel and gusset

- ① Fold the seam of the opening side of the panel in three. Pull up the handle and elastic and sew.

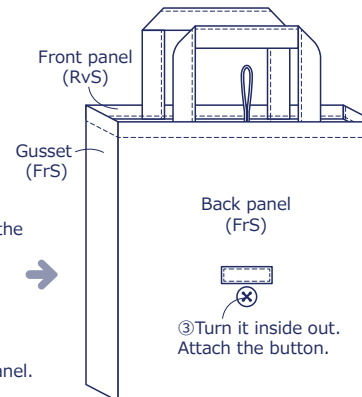


- Repeat the same process for the front panel.

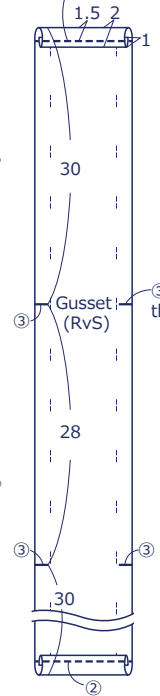


- ④ With the front sides facing each other, sew together the front panel and gusset.

- ⑤ With the front sides facing each other, sew together the back panel and gusset.



- ② Fold the seam of the opening side of the gusset in three and sew.



- ③ Cut a slit on the seam.
