



# Round Bottom Bag

Design & work: Kokka Fabric

Size: about 25cm (l)  
about 42.5cm (w)  
about 27cm (bottom)  
(Handle excluded)

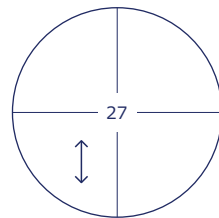
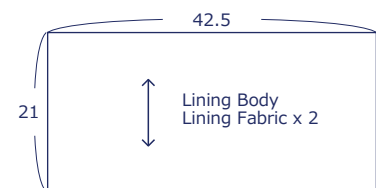
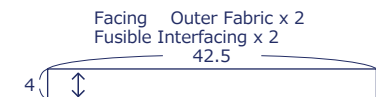
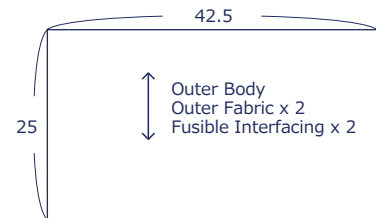
## Materials

- Outer Fabric: 110cm wide x 70cm
- Lining Fabric: 90cm wide x 60cm
- Fusible Interfacing (heavy weight): 110cm wide x 70cm

Fabric shown for this sample: YPA-29020-2B

## Pattern

Unit: cm Add 1cm seam allowance all around when cutting the fabric.



Bottom  
Outer Fabric x 1  
Lining Fabric x 1  
Fusible Interfacing x 1

※Adhere fusible interfacing on the back of all the outer fabrics.

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## Instructions Front Side - (FrS), Reverse Side (RvS)

### 1. Make the handles

With the front sides facing each other, fold the handle in half and sew with 1cm seam allowance.

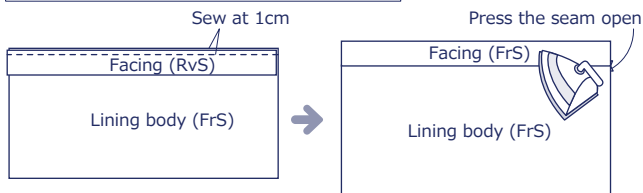


Turn the handle inside out. Place the stitch line in the center and press with an iron.

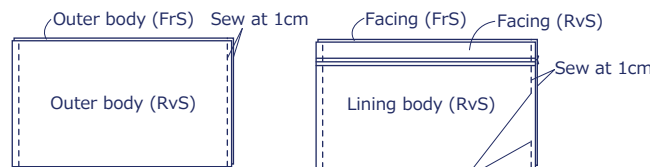


Press the seam open.

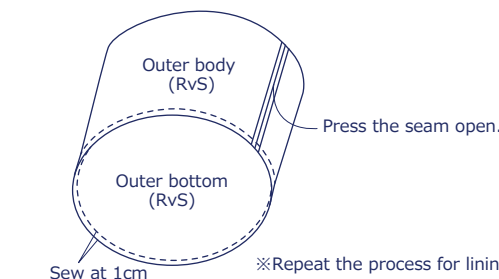
### 2. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the lining body and facing



### 3. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the bag bodies at the sides respectively

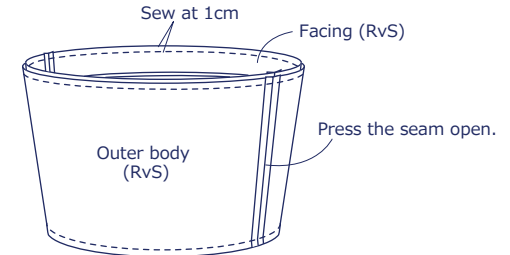


### 4. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the bag body and bottom

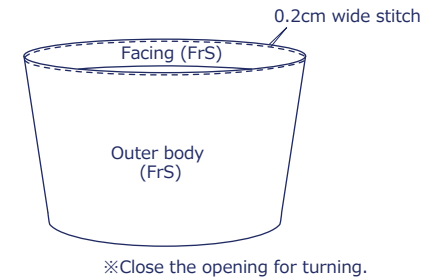


※Repeat the process for lining fabrics.

### 5. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the outer bag and lining bag at the opening



### 6. Turn the bag inside out using an opening for turning. Apply stitching around the top opening.



### 7. Attach the handle to finish
