### Materials

- Fabric (Bag Body Outer Fabric, Handle): 50cm×70cm  
(Bag Body Lining Fabric): 32cm×46cm  
(Opening Fabric): 40cm×30cm
- Quilt Batting: 32cm×46cm

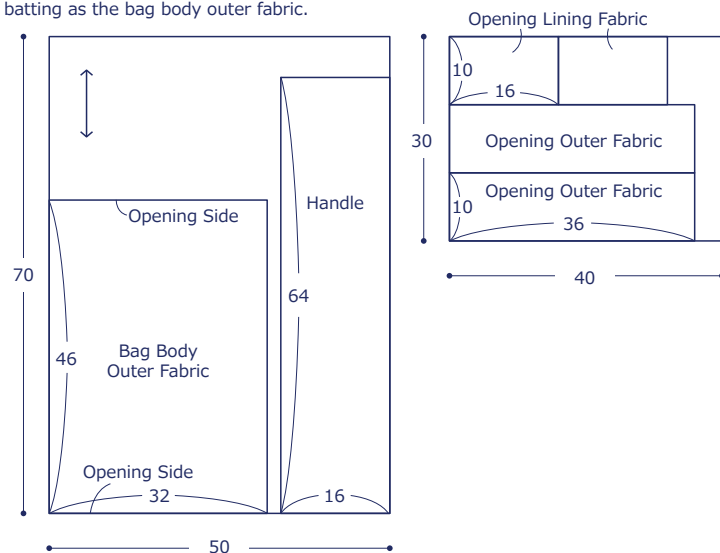

### Pattern and Cutting Layout

Unit: cm All raw edge

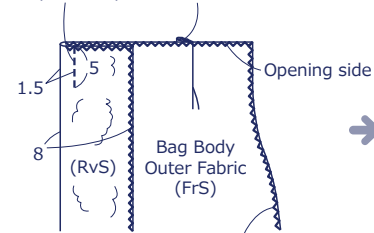
Use the same measurement for bag body lining fabric and quilt batting as the bag body outer fabric.



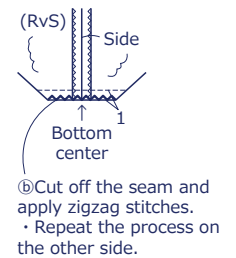
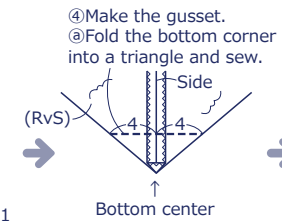
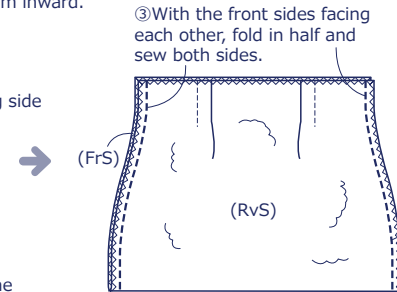
### Instructions Front Side - (FrS), Reverse Side (RvS)

#### 1. Make the outer bag

- ② Sew the tuck and press down the seam inward.  
• Repeat the process on the other side.



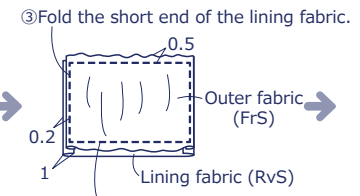
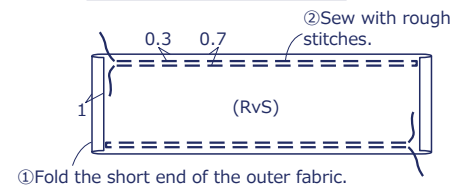
- ① Layer the quilt batting over the bag body outer fabric.  
Apply zigzag stitches on side edges.



#### 2. Make the lining bag

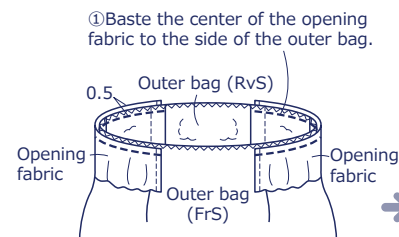
- Using the lining fabric, repeat the process as in ① - ②~④.  
(In step ②, press down the tuck outward. In step ③, leave an opening for turning for 10cm on one side.)

#### 3. Make the opening fabric

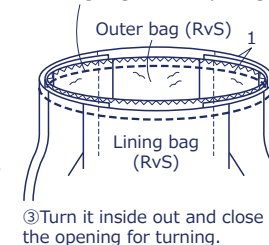


- ④ Pull the thread from ② tight. With the front sides facing outside, sew together with the lining fabric and remove the thread from ②.
- ⑤ With the front sides facing outside, fold the outer fabric in half and baste.  
• Make two pieces.

#### 4. Make the bag body

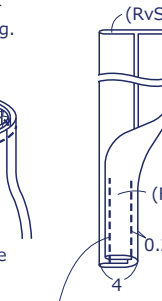


- ② With the front sides facing each other, sew together the outer and lining bags at the opening.

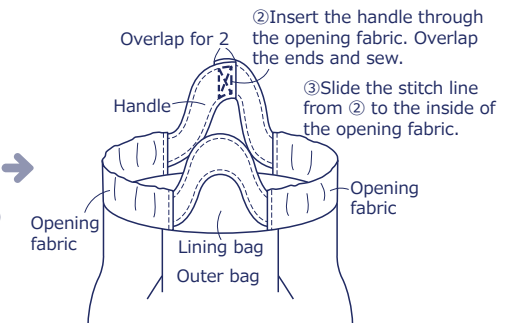


- ③ Turn it inside out and close the opening for turning.

#### 5. Make the handle and finish the bag



- ① With the front sides facing outside, fold the handle in four and sew.



- ② Insert the handle through the opening fabric. Overlap the ends and sew.
- ③ Slide the stitch line from ② to the inside of the opening fabric.
