



Pouch with a Zippered Pocket

Size: 15cm (l) 22cm (w-at opening) 17cm (bottom) 5cm (gusset width)

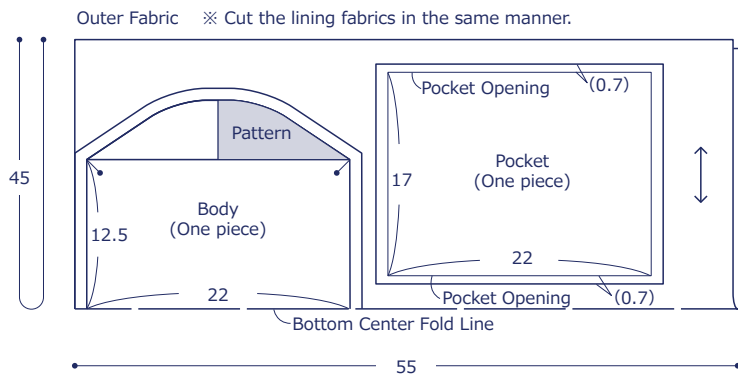
Materials

- Fabric (Outer Fabric): 55cm×45cm (Lining Fabric): 55cm×45cm
- Shank Button: 1 pair (2cm diameter)
- Flatknit Zipper: One piece (20cm long)

Fabric shown for this sample: (Outer Fabric) YKA-96010-2E

Pattern and Cutting Layout

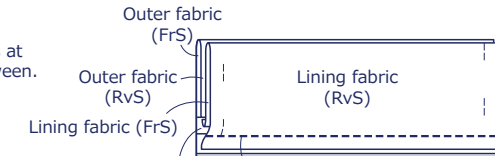
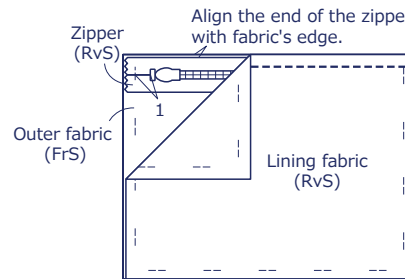
Unit: cm 1cm seam allowance unless numbers in () denote otherwise.



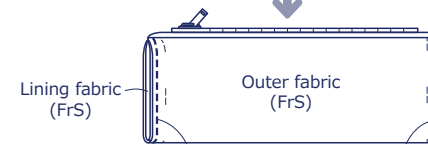
Instructions Front Side - (FrS), Reverse Side (RvS)

1. Make the pocket

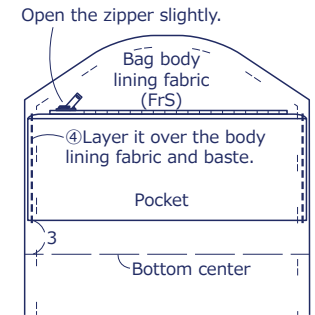
① With the front sides facing each other, sew together the outer and lining fabrics at the pocket opening with a zipper in between.



② Repeat the same process as in ① on the other side.



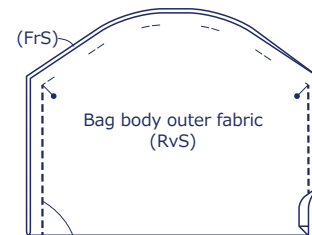
③ Turn it over and baste both ends.



Open the zipper slightly.

④ Layer it over the body lining fabric and baste.

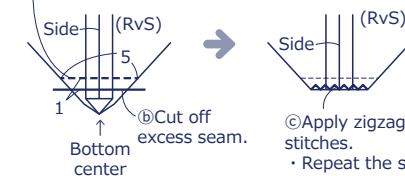
2. Make the outer bag



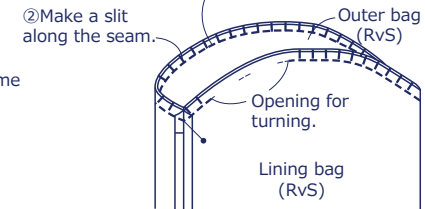
① With the front sides facing each other, fold the body outer fabric in half. Sew up to where indicated and press the seam open.

② Make the gusset

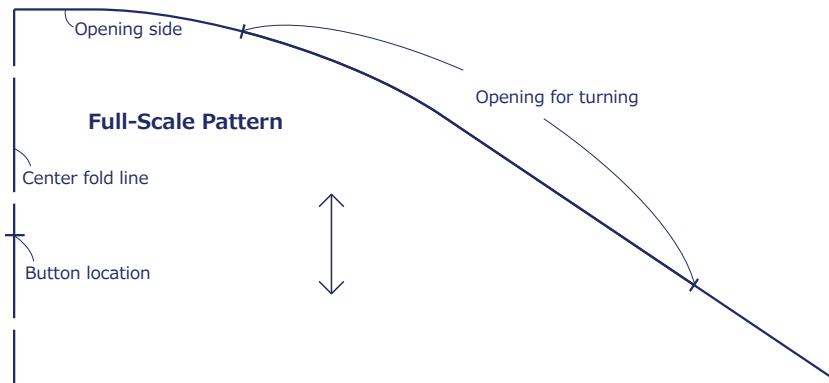
③ Fold the bottom corner into a triangle and sew.



④ Apply zigzag stitches. Repeat the same process on the other side.



② Make a slit along the seam.

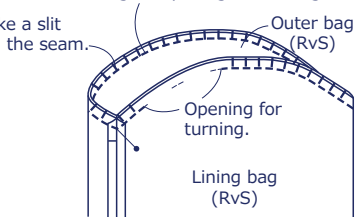


3. Make the lining bag

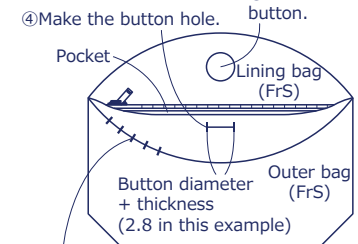
Using the body lining fabric, follow the process as in ②.

4. Finish the pouch

① With the front sides facing each other, sew together the outer and lining bags at the top opening, leaving an opening for turning.



② Attach the button.



③ Turn it inside out and close the opening for turning.
