

Bag with Frills

Design & work: Kokka Fabric

Size: about 35cm (I) x about 45cm (w)

(excluding handles and frills)

Materials


□ Outer Fabric: about 110cm wide x 80cm ☐ Lining Fabric: about 110cm wide x 40cm


☐ Fusible Interfacing (heavy weight): about 110cm wide x 50cm

Fabric shown for this sample: YGA-59060-1D

Pattern

Unit: Centimeters (cm) Add 1cm seam allowances when cutting the fabric.










X Adhere fusible interfacing on the back of the bag outer fabrics and handles.

Instructions Front Side - (FrS), Reverse Side (RvS)

1. Make the handle and baste it to the bag outer fabric Fold it to the finished measurement and apply stitches on both long ends.


Handle (FrS) Fold for 1cm. 0.2cm wide stitch Make two pieces.




* Repeat the process with the other handle and bag outer fabric.


2. Make the frill and baste it to the bag outer fabric

With the front sides facing each other, piece together.



With the front sides facing each other, sew both short ends.





3. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the sides and bottom


Sew at 1cm and press the seam open.



Sew at 1cm and press the seam open.

Lining bag fabric (RvS) Leave an opening for turning (about 12cm)

4. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the bag fabrics at the top opening



5. Turn it over and apply stitches around the bag opening to finish



Align the seamline of the frill and matchmark.
